AUSTRIA, MAY 9, 1972

Passing strange to read the papers in German here: *die Amerikanische Luftwaffe* half a world away poised for God knows what last Nixonic thunder before the last silence and twilight of the gods.

Watching the mountain I read in the apple orchard, bask like a lizard in the morning sun.

In my landlord's hall the framed photo hangs, shows him proud, erect in Luftwaffe uniform beside his shining tri-motor training plane.

Now he limps among his apple trees, scything the long grass, heaping it in rings around the trunks. He props the leaning trees with sticks, gives them canes like the one he leans on.

The mountain is lost in a cloud; in the orchard the sun still shines, and bees drone in the apple-blossoms; the birds are unperturbed; from the mountain comes mutter of thunder.
