Assessment methods

1) Student attending the course

The exam consists of:

- Two mid-terms during the course, one on Elena Argentesi's part and one on Liliane Karlinger's part.

- First mid-term: Tuesday, October 19th from 1pm to 3pm
- Second mid-term: Wednesday, November 17th from 5pm to 7pm

The two mid-terms will consist in open questions.

- Discussion of antitrust cases by students (in small groups). Case discussion will be scheduled just after the second mid-term.

- The three parts of the exam will have the following weights in the determination of the final grade:

- First mid-term: 20%
- Second mid-term: 50%
- Discussion of an antitrust case in class: 30%

2) Students not attending the course

Written exam on the full program during the January/February session (or following sessions). The exam will consist in open questions on the full program, including the antitrust cases assigned during the course (which will be available at this webpage).

NOTE: Only for the first mid-term, students can choose whether they want to answer the exam questions in English or in Italian. The second mid-term, the discussion of antitrust cases in class and all the written exams in the following sessions for non-attending students will be in English.
