Assessment methods

1) Student attending the course

The exam consists of:

- a) Two mid-terms during the course:
 - First mid-term: Friday, October 14th from 11am to 1pm
 - Second mid-term: Friday, November 11th from 11am to 1pm

The two mid-terms will consist in open questions.

- b) Discussion of antitrust cases by students (in small groups).

The three parts of the exam will have the following weights in the determination of the final grade:

- First mid-term: 40%
- Second mid-term: 40%
- Discussion of an antitrust case in class: 20%

2) Students not attending the course

Written exam on the full program during the January/February session (or following sessions). The exam will consist in open questions on the full program, including the antitrust cases assigned during the course (which will be available at this webpage).
