



Grafico 1: Crescita del PIL (% annuale), MENA, 2000-2010





Grafico 2: Contributo settoriale al PIL, 2000-2010, MENA (tutti i Paesi, All Incomes)





Grafico 3: Contributo settoriale al PIL, 2000-2010, MENA, (Paesi in via di sviluppo, Developing Countries)








Grafico 6: US\$/barile di petrolio, Brent Rated 1984-2010

Grafico 7: Indici Globali dei Prezzi, Banca Mondiale (Nominal US\$ Prices, 2000=100)


Figure 1: World Bank Global Price Indices (nominal U.S. dollar prices, 2000 = 100)

Grafico 8: Inflazione dei prezzi alimentari nei Paesi MENA


Figure 7: Food Price Inflation in Middle East and North Africa Region




