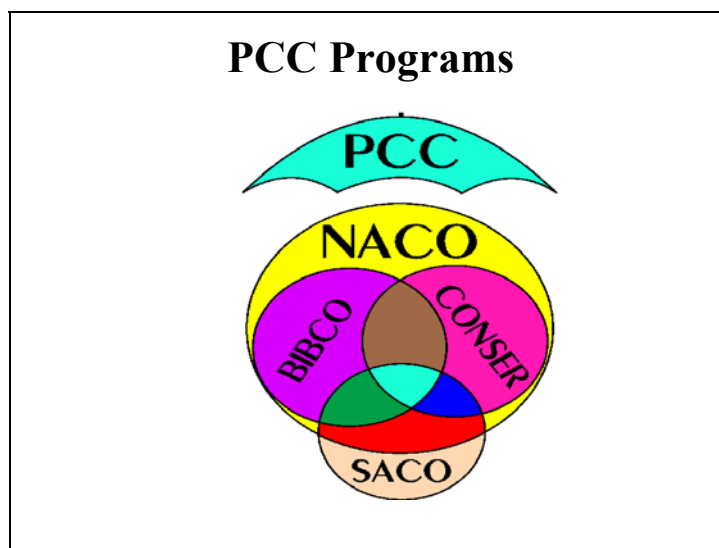



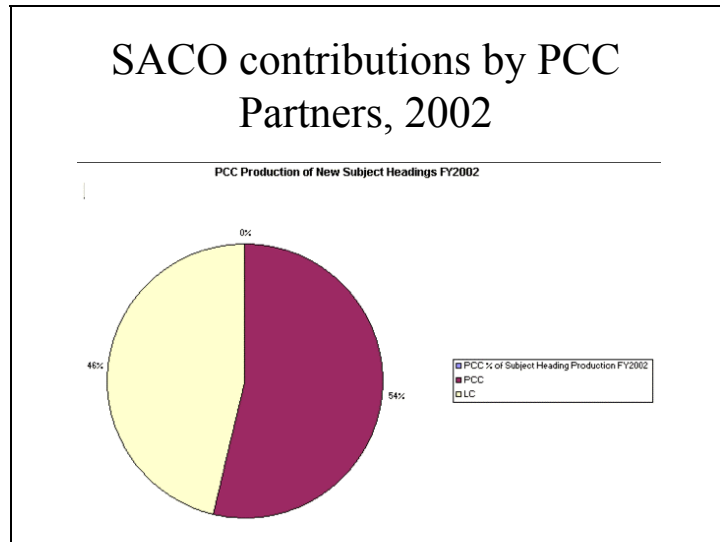

- Submit a final report to the PCC Standing Committee on Standards and the Standing Committee on Training outlining the group's findings and recommendations

MACS aims to provide multilingual subject access to library catalogues. MACS enables users to simultaneously search the catalogues of the project's partner libraries in the language of their choice (English, French, German). The partners are: the [Swiss National Library \(SNL\)](#), project leader, the [Bibliothèque nationale de France \(BnF\)](#), The [British Library \(BL\)](#) and [Die Deutsche Bibliothek \(DDB\)](#).
