Since the 1970s, twice as many people now lose their homes due to natural disasters.

In order for the effects of natural disasters to be less devastating, people need to take action before the events take place. For every \$1 spent on preparation, it can save \$3 to \$7. However, governments have spent approximately \$14 billion on natural disaster responses and only about \$500 million on preparation and prevention.

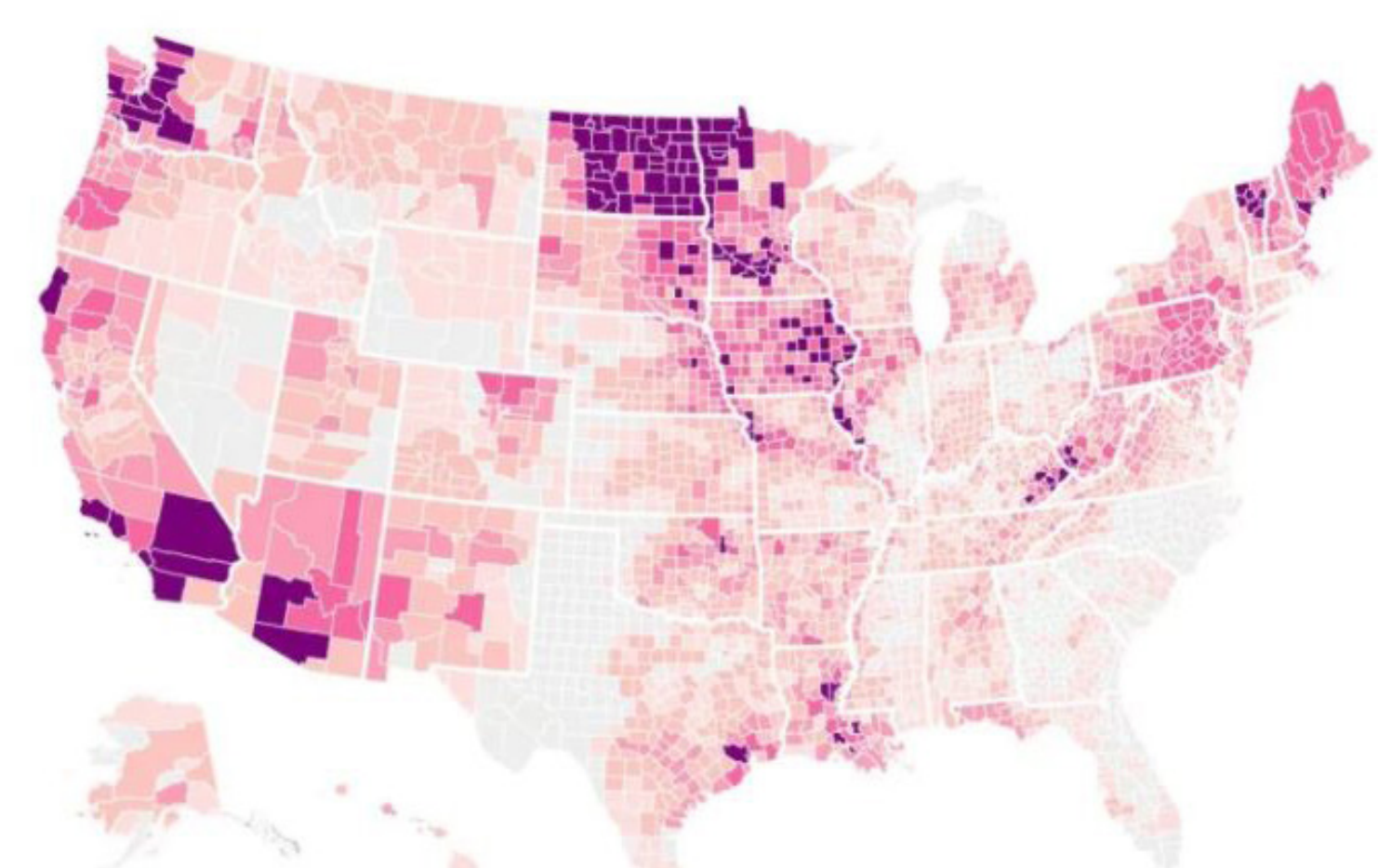
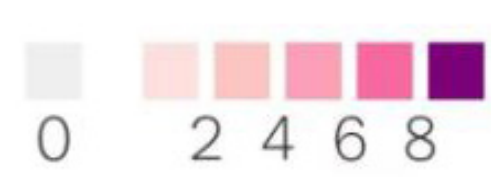

To be prepared

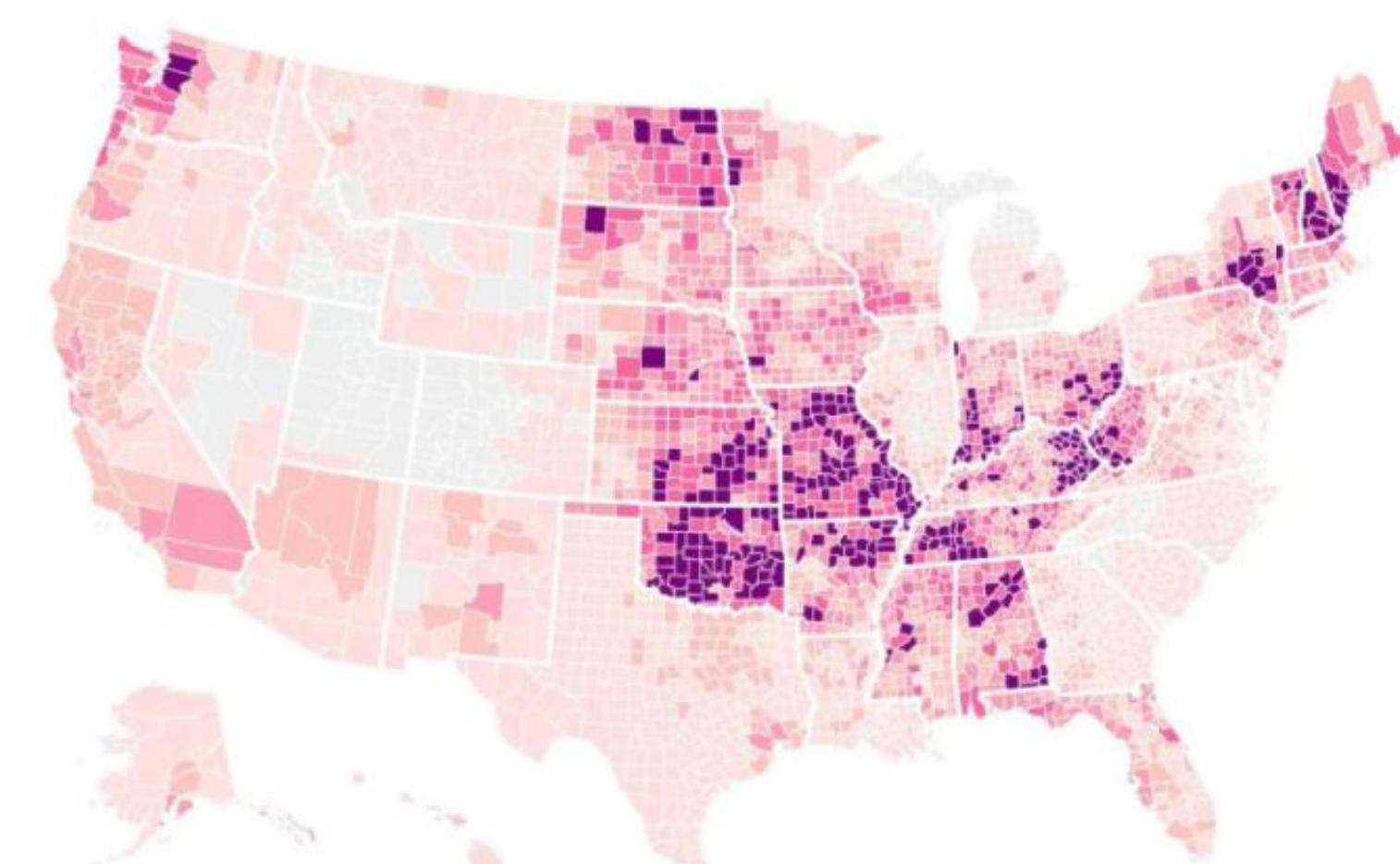
This product provides emergency relief, resources, and temporary shelter to victims of natural disasters who have been displaced.

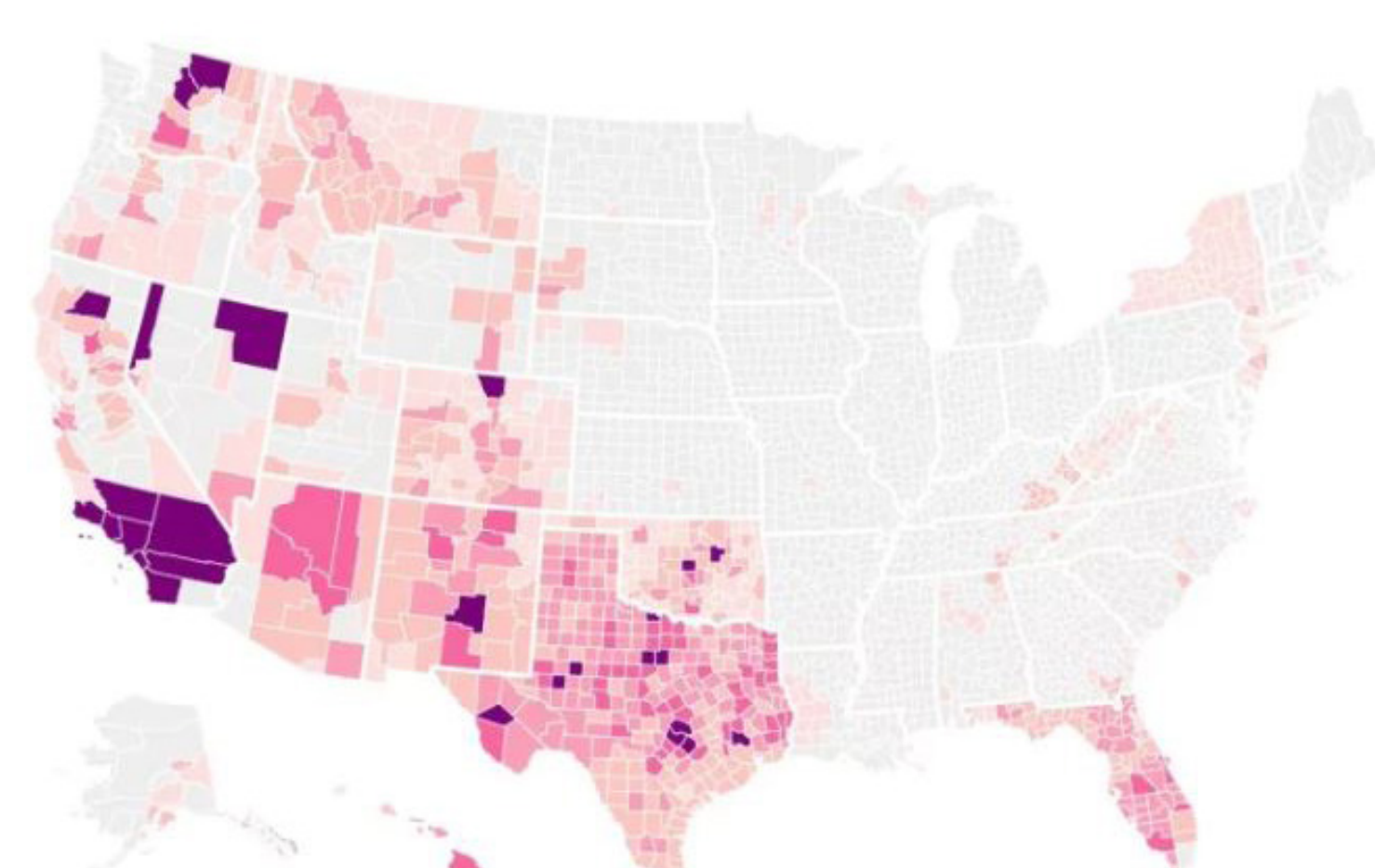
