In order for the effects of natural disasters to be less devastating, people need to take action before the events take place. For every \$1 spent on preparation, it can save \$3 to \$7. However, governmentshavespentapproximately\$14billion on natural disaster responses and only about \$500 million on preparation and prevention.
