

In collaboration with the Miniaci Center of Performing Arts' event, The Point of Pas De Deux: A Dance Dialogue on Nov. 12th, the artistic director of Dimensions Dance Theater of Miami, Jennifer Kronenberg, will be teaching a Master class in our Performance Theatre!

Dimensions Dance Theatre of Miami... is a brand new ballet company founded in 2016 by former Miami City Ballet principal dancers Carlos Guerra and Jennifer Kronenberg. Carlos and Jennifer plan to offer audiences a fresh and diverse view of ballet through their direction of Dimensions Dance Theatre of Miami, exploring collaborative avenues that are distinct in their reflection of South Florida. The CAHSS Department of Performing & Visual Arts will be hosting a master class with renowned bassist, producer, and music director, Pete Iannacone.

Iannacone will discuss his 20+ years of experience in the music industry as well as give performance, composition/production suggestions.


