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



Build Closets FOR YOUR CLOTHES



Katie had some good strong boxes and crates. The store owner gave her some packing boxes.

Look what Katie did with her boxes.





She used a big box to make a closet. It was a box that a refrigerator was packed in.

Katie's tips for building closets.

Put the $\frac{\text{rod}}{\text{rod}}$ at least 56 inches from the floor. Put the $\frac{\text{rod}}{\text{rod}}$ 14 inches from the back wall. Leave a $\frac{14}{3}$ -inch space above the rod.


This makes your clothes easy to take in and out of the closet.





Katie says, "Look inside for more good closets you can build."

This is an "idea" bulletin. It does not tell how to make.



Build a closet on a wall.

Make a closet in a corner.

Katie likes to hang a curtain in front of her closet.

It looks nice and keeps the clothes cleaner.



For short clothes, put 2 rods in one closet. Put the top rod about 58 inches from the floor.

On the top rod, hang:

-pants

-skirts

-suits

-blouses

-shirts


Put the bottom rod about 30 inches from the floor.


Put your children's clothes on the bottom rod.

Then your children can:


- -get their own clothes
- -learn to dress themselves
- -learn to be neat and hang up their clothes.


You may want to make this closet taller.





More Places To Keep Clothes





She used a crate to put dirty clothes in.

You can use a cardboard box for dirty clothes, too. But you should cut small holes in the sides to let air in.
