Summary

CPWF is currently in the process of setting up a Research Into Use (RIU) program. The program will pursue opportunities to generate impacts from high potential Phase 1 projects which were not carried over to Phase 2 because they were outside the geographic and /or scientific focus of the Phase 2 basin development challenge programs. Approximately five projects will be selected and invited to follow-up their Phase 1 work with the specific objectives to:

- Facilitate adoption of innovations - scaling out and scaling up
- Capture and characterize high potential innovations, mechanisms and approaches
- Test with development partners the relevance and acceptability of research results
- Further develop innovations: technologies, policies, institutions, and infrastructure
- Further synthesize learning from CPWF Phase 1 experience
