Objectives of the research

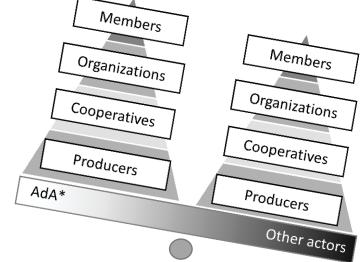
Identification and evaluation of the relationships between the factors of the conceptual framework

Research hypotheses

- 1. The structure of the Alliance has an impact on conduct and both have impact on performance
- 2. More trust between actors of the alliance leads to better performance of each member or partner
- 3. Members or partners of the *Alianza de Aprendizaje* have been capacitated to undertake agribusiness
