

Papers must be submitted in English.

Authors are requested to submit a brief biographical sketch of up to 100 words for each author.

Captions for figures and tables must be given on a separate sheet and included at the end of the manuscript.

Page margins	The margins of the top, the bottom, the left and the right should be 25mm, respectively.
Title	18 point, the first letter of major words need to be capitalized, single column, aligned in center, bold
Subtitle	12 point, single column, aligned in center, bold
Names of authors	12 point, single column, aligned in center, bold
Affiliations & mailing addresses	10 point, written in Times (New) Roman letters, aligned in center, the margins of the left and right are 30 mm each; All line spacing to be single, italic
Abstract	10 point, the margins of the left and right are 30 mm each; All line spacing to be 1.5 times the font size. Justified
Keywords	3-5 words, 10 point, written in Times (New) Roman letters, aligned to the left margin
Body text	10 point; All line spacing should be 1.5 times the font size ; First line of paragraphs to be aligned to left margin. Paragraph spacing should be added 0.5 times the font size.
Titles	Written in bold letters, aligned to the left side. Authors should make generous use of section and subsection titles, numbered consecutively (1., 1.1.,1.2.,2.,etc.), to enable the reader to identify the portions of their interest. The titles should be written with bold letters, which are 11 point size and should be aligned with the left
References	<p>The letters should be written with Times (New) Roman font and 10 point. References in the text to published literature, should be given by numbers in square brackets on the line (e.g. [1], [1,2], [3 - 8]), and the references should be listed at the end of the paper in numerical order.</p> <p>Journal references should be arranged thus:</p> <p>1. L. A. Pipes, Matrix analysis of heat transfer problems. J. Franklin Inst. 263, 195-206 (1957).</p> <p>Book references should be given as:</p> <p>2. P. H. Parkin and H. R. Illustrations	All figures are to have a caption with Times (New) Roman letters, which are 10 point size, and should be numbered consecutively. The figure caption should be typed below the illustration, aligned to the medium side of the illustration. They should be embedded in the manuscript, and should be adequately included within the text. They should keep the above-mentioned margins.
Tables	Tables should be numbered consecutively and given a suitable caption and should be adequately embedded in the text. The table caption should be typed above the table, aligned to the left side of the table. Tables should keep within the margins. Large tables should be avoided. If there is a large volume of data to be presented, an attempt should be made to divide these over two or more tables. Each table should have a brief and self-explanatory title with Times (New) Roman letters, which are 10 point size. Column headings should be brief, but sufficiently explanatory.
