## **University Associates** groundbreaking ceremony to be held Saturday, Nov. 2, 1991

All staff and employees are invited to a groundbreaking ceremony for the Medical Center's University Associates project on Saturday, Nov. 2, at 2 p.m. at the construction site for the first building, the Boston University Center for Advanced Biomedical Research, on Albany Street.

The ceremony will include brief remarks by Mayor Raymond L. Flynn, Boston University President John Silber, J. Scott Abercrombie Jr., M.D., president of the University Hospital, Aram V. Chobanian, M.D., dean of the School of Medicine, Spencer R. Frankl, D.D.S., dean of the Goldman School of Graduate Dentistry, and Judith Kurland, Boston's Commissioner of Health and Hospitals.

The University Associates project, a joint venture of Boston University and the University Hospital, will open a new era in BUMC health-care and medical-research programs. Phase One of the project involves construction of the Boston University School of Medicine's 180,000-square-foot Center for Advanced Biomedical Research; a 1,000-car parking garage and day-care center, and a new medical office complex, with retail activities in all of the buildings. Phase Two, to begin in several years, will fill out the complex with construction of a hotel/conference center and two additional medical-research facilities.
