AIDS pledge walk coming up this Sunday

BUMCH employees can bring new meaning to the acronym AIDS, transforming it to "Awareness, Involvement, Dedication, Support," by participating in the 8th annual "From All Walks of Life" pledge walk this Sunday, June 6. More than 30,000 people are expected to turn out for the 6.2-mile walk, which begins on the Boston Common and ends with a huge party at the Hatch Shell on the Esplanade.



If employees do not register here, they will need to register on the Boston Common on the morning of the walk.

- Each walker will be eligible for the following special gifts from the AIDS Action Committee: for a \$250 donation, a walk tee-shirt; for \$500, a special edition walk sweatshirt; and, for \$1,000, a pair of New Balance athletic

The walk, New England's largest fund-raiser for AIDS education and research, benefits more than 30 AIDS service organizations throughout Massachusetts.

BUMCH employees who are interested in walking should read the following information:

- Employees may register for the walk with representatives from the AIDS Action Committee on Friday, June 4, from 1 to 3 p.m., on the H-2 bridge. **IN ORDER TO REGISTER, EMPLOYEES MUST HAVE COLLECTED THEIR PLEDGE MONEY AND BE ABLE TO SUBMIT IT.**

- Check-in will be in the Atrium Lobby on the morning of the walk, from 7 to 8 a.m. The first 75 walkers representing the Hospital will receive complimentary walk tee-shirts. Balloons, hats and water bottles will also be available. Employees who wish to walk as a team may meet the BUMCH Walk Team at 8:30 a.m., at the fountain on the Boston Common by the Park Street MBTA station.
- There will be free parking for walkers in Lot A on the day of the walk, as well as free shuttle transportation from 7 to 8 a.m. and from 1 to 3:30 p.m.
