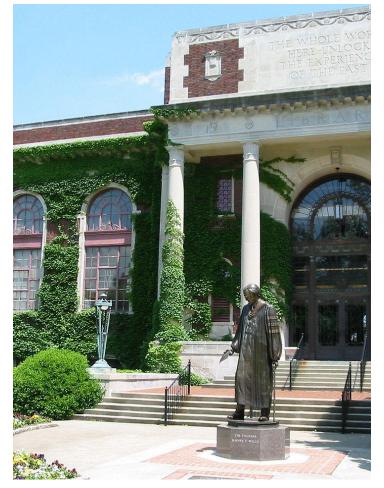

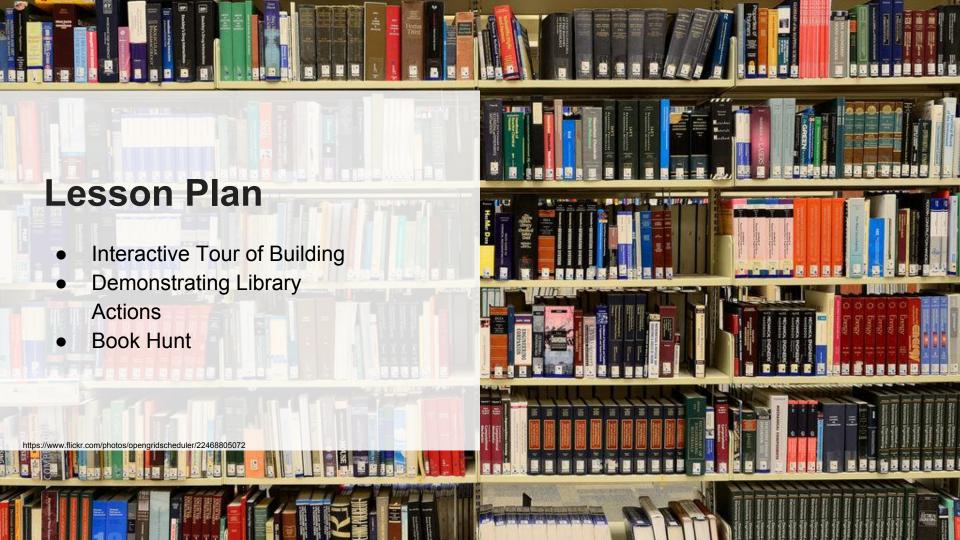
- Student needs

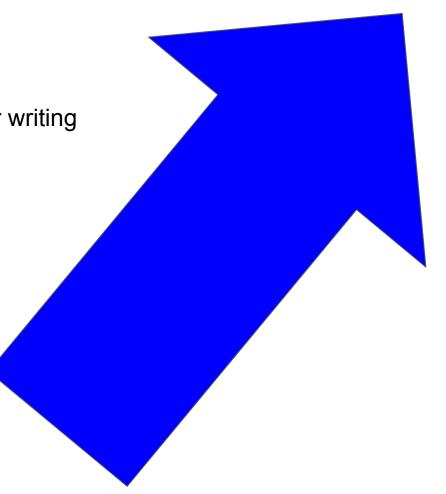


The ESL Scaffold: How has it worked?
