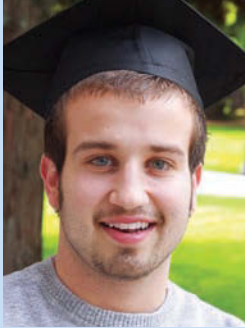

Math

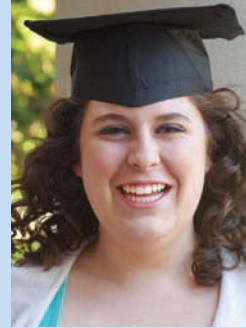
I will attend the University of Arizona for a master's degree in biostatistics.
