**Plantings**

Thanks to a recent survey by Verner Anderson, there is now a summary of actual plantings of the major varieties in Douglas County by varietal, number of vines and acres.

White Riesling, 21,991 — 47 acres, Chardonnay, 7,899 — 17, Gewurztraminer, 8,963 — 20, Sauvignon Blanc, 1,829 — four, Chenin Blanc, 612 — one, Cabernet Sauvignon, 11,434 — 25, Pinot Noir, 12,632 — 28, Gamay Beaujolais, 1,253 — one, Pinot Noir, 1,000 — two, Semillon, 900 — one, and Merlot, 402 — one.
