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
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JLC Winery dba Spofford Station Vineyards/James Leigh Cellars

James Leigh Cellars was established in 2001 as a premium red wine, boutique winery located in the Walla Walla Valley. Owner/winemaker, Lynne Chamberlain is from a third generation Walla Walla ranch and farm family. The Estate vineyard was started in 1998. Chamberlain is a charter student of the Walla Walla Enology and Viticulture program. She is the President of the Washington State Association of Wine Grape Growers. The farm grows wheat, peas, mint and cattle as well as grapes.

James Leigh Cellars (Spofford Station Vineyard) has been an active participant in the Walla Walla Valley Wine Alliance and a contributor and leader in media wine maker dinners, pouring and tours. Chamberlain was first Viticulture Representative and is on marketing board.
