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1995 OREGON VINEYARD REPORT

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Wine Grape Acreage, Production and Value Reach New Highs

Oregon's 1995 wine grape crop was a record 14,000 tons, 13 percent above the prior largest crops of 1993 and 1992. Value of this season's crop totaled \$13.4 million, up 37 percent from the previous record set in 1993. Harvested acreage continued a record setting trend, up 8 percent from last year's prior high. Funding for the 1995 Vineyard Survey was provided by the Oregon Wine Advisory Board.
