The major issue of this study is what and how causes of sex and aggression reflected in *The Great Gatsby* novel (1925) by F. Scott Fitzgerald?. The objective of this study is, 1) to describe *The Great Gatsby* novel based on structural elements of novel, and 2) to analyze sex and aggression in *The Great Gatsby* novel (1925 by F. Scott Fitzgerald based on a Psychoanalytic Criticism).

The research is qualitative study. The researcher uses primary data source and secondary data source. The primary data sources *The Great Gatsby* novel by F. Scott Fitzgerald and the secondary data sources related the study, such as: website, dictionary, some books that support the analysis. The data collection method used by the researcher is reading the novel, taking notes, arranging the data, selecting particular parts of the script, determining the character that will be analyzed, classifying and determining the relevant data and browsing on internet.
