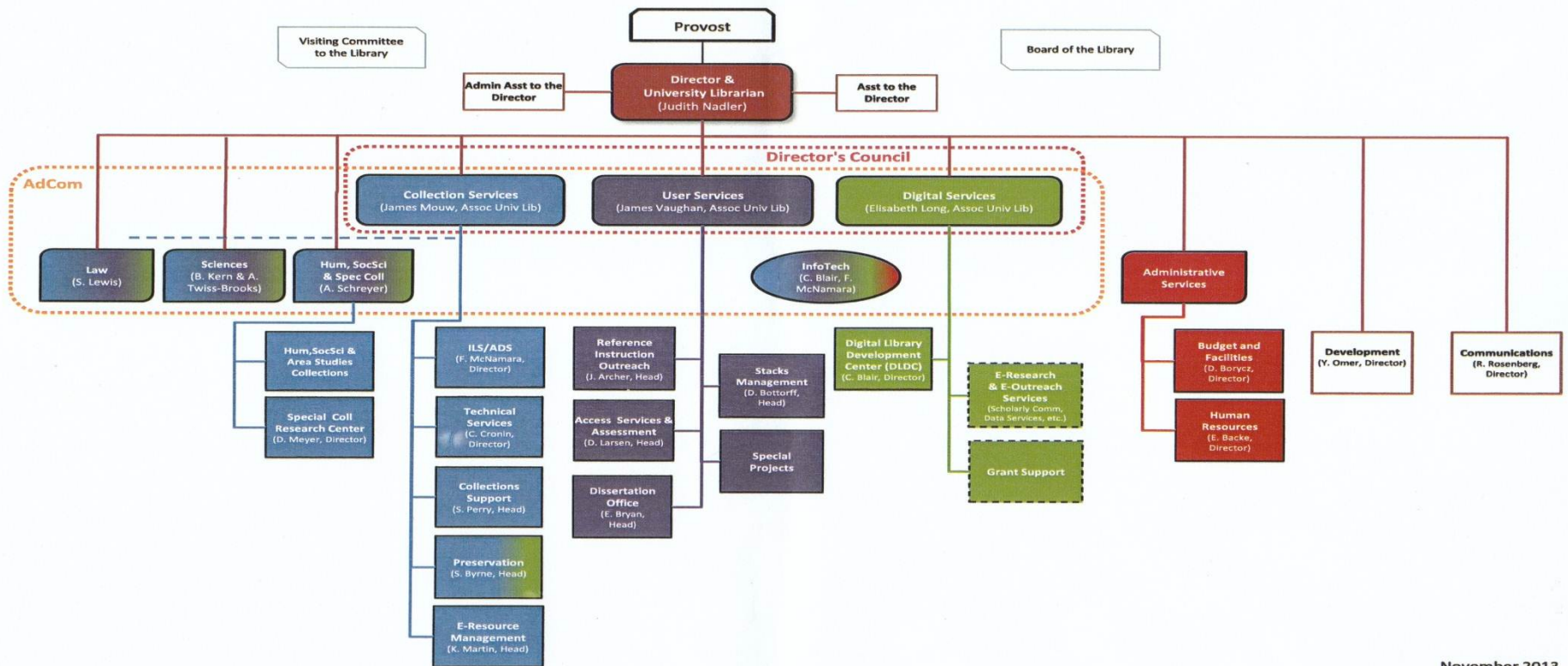

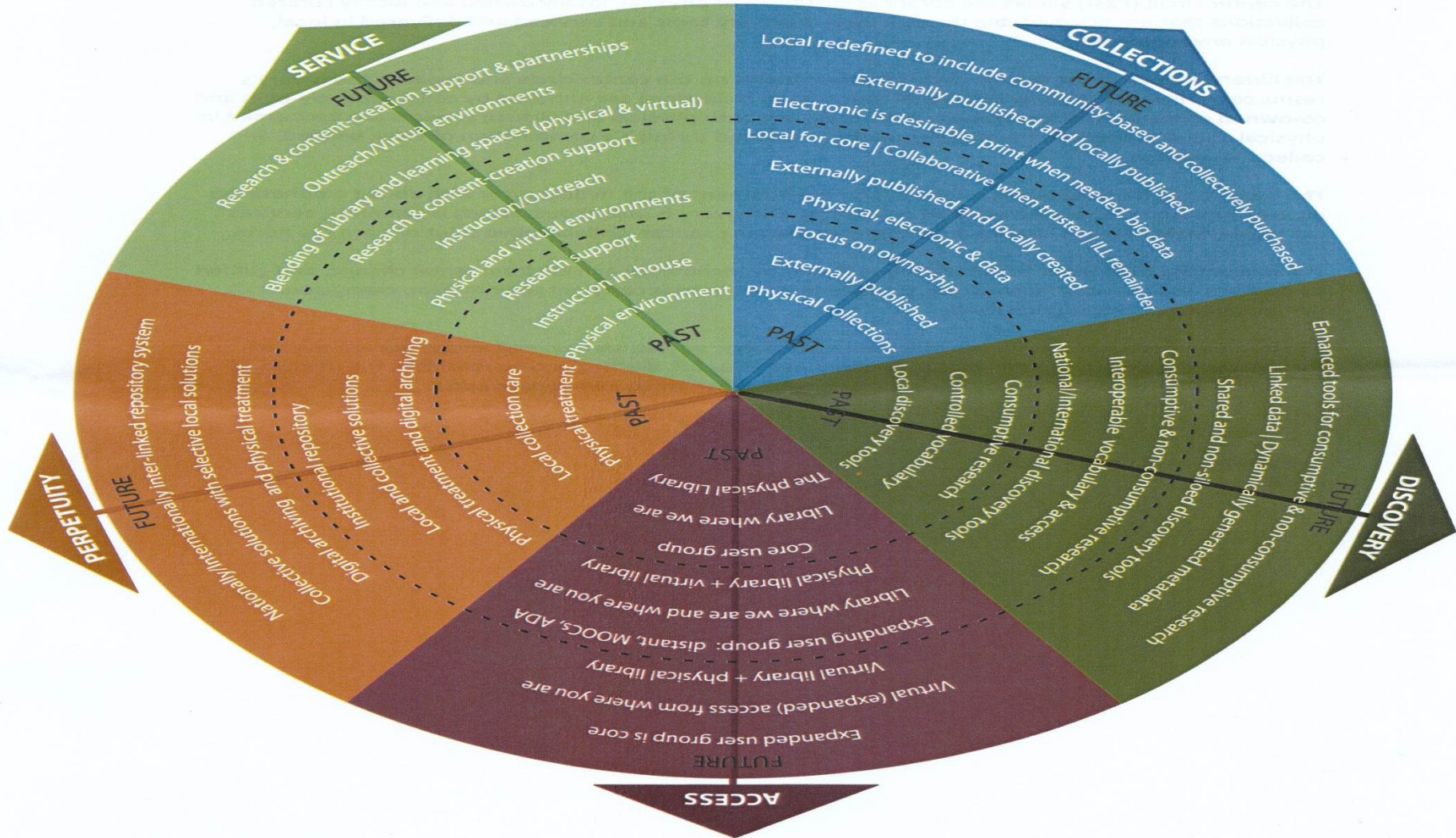
The University of Chicago Library Organizational Structure

## A Gift from Joe and Rika Mansueto

In Spring 2008, Joe and Rika Mansueto made an extraordinary gift of \$25 million to the University of Chicago. In recognition of their generosity, the University will name a new, state-of-the-art library for them.

"I am grateful to the Mansuetos for their generous gift and their commitment to the fundamental values of the University which will have lasting impact on our campus and our community," said President Robert J. Zimmer.

Joe Mansueto, Chairman and CEO of Morningstar, Inc., received his bachelor's degree from the University in 1978 and his MBA from the Graduate School of Business in 1980; Rika Mansueto received her bachelor's degree in 1991.

Joe founded Morningstar, a premier investment research, analysis, and information firm, in 1984. Rika was an editor at Morningstar for several years. Joe received a University of Chicago Alumni Association Professional Achievement Award in 2003 and the Graduate School of Business Distinguished Alumnus Award in 2000.

"Like most students at the University, we found the Library to be a central part of the experience. Our typical days included going to Regenstein every night," Joe Mansueto said. "It was really interwoven into our daily routines at the University. So when we were looking to give a gift to the school, a new library resonated with us."



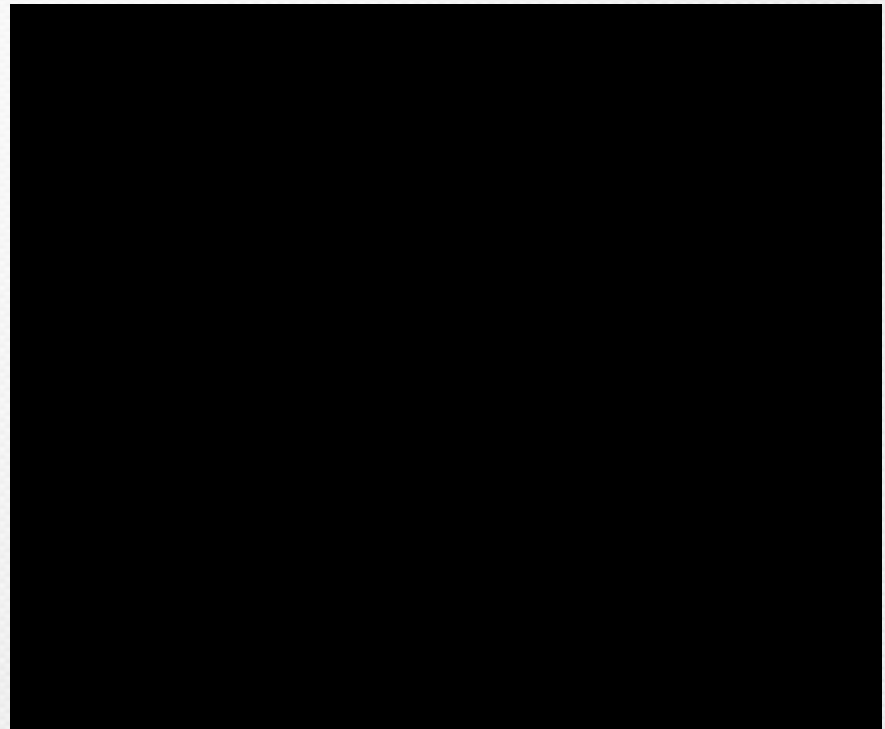
