An Act to amend the Fisheries Act, 1917-1946.

[Assented to 15th November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fisheries Act Amend- short titles. ment Act, 1956".
- (2) The Fisheries Act, 1917-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Fisheries Act, 1917-1956".
- (3) The Fisheries Act, 1917-1946, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of principal Act after section 7 thereof:—

s. 7a of principal Act-

7a. (1) The Minister shall have the following powers, namely:---

Accommoda-tion for fishing boats.

- (a) to provide all or any of the following accommodation for fishing boats, namely, boat harbours, jetties, wharves, mooring places, slips and other like accommodation:
- (b) to impose and recover charges for the use of any such accommodation, and in cases of hardship to compound or remit any such charges or part thereof:

- (c) with the approval of the Governor to arrange with any other Minister or authority of the Crown for the construction of any such accommodation.
- (2) The cost of providing any such accommodation shall be defrayed out of money voted by Parliament for the purpose.
