An Act to amend the Land Settlement Act, 1944-1955.

[Assented to 31st October, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act Amendment Act, 1957".
- (2) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1955, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act, 1944-1957".
- (3) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1955, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Repeal of Land Settlement Act Extension Act, 1956. 3. The Land Settlement Act Extension Act, 1956, is repealed.

Amendment of principal Act. s. 5—
Term of office.

- 4. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the principal Act is repealed and the following subsection inserted in lieu thereof:—
 - (1) Subject to section 6 of this Act, every member of the Committee holding office at the time of the passing of the Land Settlement Act Amendment Act, 1957, and any person appointed to a casual vacancy occurring on

the Committee before the thirty-first day of December, 1958, shall hold office until the thirty-first day of December,

5. Section 27a of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of out the word "nine" in the fourth line of subsection (4) and 5. 27a inserting in lieu thereof the word "ten".
