SFRB Policy Changes FY2013-2014

- No organizational funding is guaranteed (year to year)
 - No limit on potential increase/decrease
- Funding based on Full Time Enrollment (FTE)
 - Organizations receive set amount
 - Funding may Increase/Decrease with enrollment
- Student representation
 - Voting Members: 5 (Undergraduate), 2 (Graduate)
 - Non-voting: 1 (Undergraduate), 2 (Graduate)

6 of 7 vote of approval



Organizational Eligibility for SFRB Funding

- ELIGIBLE
 - UNM Departmental oversight to ensure funding is spent in correct and appropriate manner
 - All Orgs. MUST submit application to be eligible

- INELIGIBLE
 - Chartered student

 organizations that
 submit ASUNM Senate
 or GPSA Council
 appropriation funds
 - Organizations independent of UNM



SFRB Funding Considerations

- Potential benefits for the entire UNM campus
- Advancement of students' learning
- Unique need on campus
- Other funding sources
- Applicability to student fees
- Justification of funding increase/decrease



Potential Funding Outcomes

- There is NO guarantee of funding
- The SFRB may direct programs to more appropriate funding sources
- The SFRB must consider access and affordability in its recommendations regarding the spending of student fees



Forming Budgets

- Include <u>all funding sources</u> (ex: I&G, Grants, Department, etc.)
- Specify which items to be **funded by SFRB**
- Amount requested per Full Time Enrollment (FTE)

(This year's FTE is 23,470. Amount Req. x FTE = Total estimated allocation.)
