About Kurt Weill

Berlin to Broadway with Kurt Weill, this evening's musical voyage, is also the personal voyage of Kurt Weill, as expressed in his songs and musical works.

Considered by major critics and vast numbers of the world's music lovers as the greatest theatre composer of this century, Kurt Weill has written melodies and music with the finest array of lyricists and poets ever to write for the theatre of the Western World, including Bertolt Brecht. Maxwell Anderson, Paul Green, Langston Hughes, Ira Gershwin, Ogden Nash, Alan Jay Lerner and others. Through his art and theirs, the journey, encompassing 36 songs, gives us a panorama of twenty extraordinary years—from von Hindenburg and Hitler in the Germany where Weill was born, to Roosevelt and Truman in the America to which Weill emigrated. A musical spectacle blending cavalcade and cabaret, commentary and tin-pan-alley, *Berlin to Broadway with Kurt Weill* inevitably becomes a tribute to theatre itself, an entertainment in salute to show business.

Kurt Weill—son of a cantor—was born March 2, 1900, in Dessau, Germany, of German-Jewish heritage traceable to the thirteenth century. His talents as composer were recognized throughout Germany by the time he was twenty-five. Both because his art was in open collision with Nazi ideology and because of his Jewish origins, he was forced to flee overnight from Berlin in March, 1933. His scores were publicly burned in front of the State Opera house, his music forever banned by the Third Reich. Together with his wife, Lotte Lenya, the pre-eminent interpreter of his songs, Weill escaped to France, where he and Miss Lenya remained for two years. In 1935, at the invitation of Director Max Reinhardt, who had come to America to escape the Nazi grip, Weill and Miss Lenya came to live in the United States. The composer never again set foot in his native Germany. He spent the remaining fifteen years of his life in his newly-adopted country, making a musical contribution to the American theatre few have rivaled. He died in New York at the age of fifty on April 3, 1950.






