







THE 1996/97 BUDGET Budget deficit as % of GDP

THE 1996/97 BUDGET Interest on state debt




HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 1996/97 Budget

- Small reduction in personal income tax
- Company tax rate unchanged
- STC rate reduced to 12,5%
- Tax imposed on retirement funds
- VAT rate unchanged
- Donations tax rate increased to 25%
- Branch profits tax imposed
- Excise duties and fuel levy increased
- MST and Stamp Duty reduced on share transfers
- Estate Duty rate increased to 25%




THE 1996/97 BUDGET Top expenditure items




