## The Dark Rationalism Glossary

## **Abstract**

Existential theorists have been working to syncretize philosophy, science, and spirituality since shortly after Galileo unknowingly initiated the schism between them. Contemporary philosophers, scientists, and theologians are still engaged in this effort, but have little to show for nearly four centuries of effort. The thesis of this article is that—despite their cooperative intentions—these theorists continue to talk past each other, due to an unacknowledged disagreement on the meaning of their overlapping terms of art. To effectively unify the divergent existential insights of philosophy, science, theism, and spirituality, it will be necessary to return to first principles. To establish an integration baseline, this article defines a diverse collection of philosophical, scientific, theistic, and spiritual expressions, in a unifying vocabulary.

## The Glossary of Terms

Note: The underlined terms in each definition are explained elsewhere within this glossary.

- Acceleration The <u>material expression</u> of any <u>changes identified</u> in the angle between the <u>objective</u> directions of <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, or <u>mental transformation</u> of an <u>observed</u>
   <u>manifestation</u>, and those of its <u>inertial observer</u>; which em<u>bodies</u> corresponding <u>changes</u> in the magnitude of its <u>subjective</u> rate of <u>dynamic translation</u>.
- Adaptation The <u>emergence</u>, within a <u>vital body</u>, of a new, <u>environment-reflecting</u> intention as an identifiable cause of its life-sustaining effects. The vital analog of memory.
- Analysis The <u>identification</u> of <u>information</u> and simple <u>knowledge</u> within complex <u>knowledge</u>.
- Anger A mental incarnation's experience of its body's impatience with its separation from that with which it desires to connect.
- Angst A mental incarnation's experience of its body's impatience with its separation from that with which it aspires to connect. Anxiety.
- Appearance An <u>incarnation</u>'s <u>experience</u> of a <u>phenomenon</u>. See **Essence**, **Truth**.
- Art Any practice that aspires to express wisdom by revealing beauty.
- **Aspiration** The will to transcend, rather than simply pursue, an imperative or intention.
- Asymmetric mind A configuration of <u>self-awareness</u>, <u>consciousness</u>, and <u>self-expression</u>,
  with <u>inexistential</u>, <u>objective</u>, and <u>subjective</u> aspects, that share it as their <u>identity</u>, in their
  unified pursuit of perfect symmetry.
- Asymmetry domain Any portion of a <u>symmetry domain</u>, whose contents are distinguishable in the context of its emergent attributes.

- Attribute An <u>identifying asymmetry</u> of a <u>being</u> or <u>category</u>. To <u>categorize</u> an <u>entity</u> as contextualizing a specific asymmetry.
- Awareness The <u>capacity</u> to <u>identify entities</u>.
- **Awe** The <u>aspiration</u> to <u>understand</u> a <u>beautiful</u> <u>phenomenon</u>.
- **Beauty (objective)** The <u>categorization</u> of <u>bodies</u> whose <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, or <u>aspirations</u> are <u>identifiable</u> as increasing the <u>symmetry</u> of a <u>manifestation</u> of their <u>inherently</u> conscious observer.
- **Beauty (subjective)** The <u>degree</u> of a <u>being</u>'s <u>harmony</u> with the <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, and aspirations of its manifest conscious observer. The identifier of the path to wisdom.
- Being An entity identified within existence. Existing with an identified asymmetry.
- **Belief** The subjective identification of an idea as truth.
- **Bliss** The transcendence of happiness and pleasure.
- **Body** An <u>entity</u>'s <u>self-expression</u> within a distinct <u>domain</u>. The transitive <u>self-expression</u> of an <u>objective identity</u>—retroactively through <u>material operands</u> of the <u>world</u> it <u>expresses</u>—as an <u>inertial manifestation</u>, whose <u>subjective expressions</u> are <u>identifiable</u> as either its incarnations or the causes of other effects within its environment.
- **Body** (mental) An <u>inertial manifestation</u> with an <u>essential aspiration</u> that is <u>subjectively</u> <u>identifiable</u> as using its <u>awareness</u> of this same <u>aspiration</u> in other <u>mental manifestations</u> within its <u>universe</u>, to shape their mutual <u>growth</u> toward <u>complete self-awareness</u>.
- **Body (temporal)** An <u>inertial manifestation</u> with an <u>essential imperative</u> that is <u>subjectively</u> <u>identifiable</u> as using the <u>energy separating</u> it from <u>temporal symmetry</u> to <u>translate</u> in that direction.

- **Body (vital)** An <u>inertial manifestation</u> with an <u>essential intention</u> that is <u>subjectively</u> <u>identifiable</u> as <u>evolving</u> its <u>adapted capacities</u> to <u>instinctively</u> shape its <u>life</u>-sustaining <u>effects</u> toward its <u>emergence</u> in an <u>environment</u> in which it <u>self-perpetuates</u>.
- Cancer The divergence of a homogenetic guest's path to <u>self-perpetuity</u> from that of its <u>living</u> host. See <u>Infection</u>.
- Capacity A <u>manifestation</u>'s use of its <u>connection</u> to the <u>unmanifest objective identity</u>'s self-expression within it, to pursue an <u>imperative</u>, intention, or aspiration.
- Category A <u>domain</u> of <u>entities</u> that are <u>identifiable</u> as sharing an <u>attribute</u>. See **Space**.
- Causal translation (objective) To <u>observe</u> a <u>world</u> whose <u>present</u> encompasses merging <u>complementary asymmetries</u>.
- Causal translation (subjective) –To experience the alignment of effects with imperatives, intentions, or aspirations.
- Causality The <u>identification</u> of the <u>transformation</u> of <u>possibility</u> into <u>certainty</u>, as being a consequence of the use of <u>energy</u>.
- Cause The <u>observer-identified imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, and <u>aspirations</u> with which an <u>effect</u> has the greatest degree of alignment.
- Certainty The <u>degree</u> to which the <u>effects</u> that <u>emerge</u> from an <u>indeterminacy</u> are retroactively determined by its <u>observer</u>'s <u>objective identity</u>. Any distinct <u>possibility</u> that either has <u>manifested</u> (positive) or can never <u>manifest</u> (negative), within a given <u>world</u>.
- Change An <u>observed material manifestation</u>'s <u>transformation</u>, which is the <u>subjective</u> expression of its <u>objective translation</u> through temporal, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental indeterminacies</u>

- <u>separating observer-sequence</u>d, <u>unmanifest possibilities</u>. To be <u>temporalize</u>d, <u>vitalize</u>d, or mentalized.
- Charge A <u>material body</u>'s <u>expression</u> into the <u>space</u> around it, as a <u>field</u>—the local subspace whose <u>operators</u> transitively <u>express</u> its <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, and <u>aspirations</u>.
- Charge (mental) A body's willful capacity to shape indeterminacies, expressed as its thoughts and emotions, which are identifiable as causes of transformations of possibilities into certainties, in accordance with its aspiration to grow toward complete self-awareness. A conscious body's personal values.
- Charge (temporal) A body's energetic capacity to shape indeterminacies, expressed as material interactions, which are identifiable as causes of transformations of possibilities into certainties, in accordance with its imperative to translate toward a world in temporal symmetry.
- Charge (vital) A <u>body</u>'s biotic <u>capacity</u> to shape <u>indeterminacies</u>, <u>expressed</u> as its <u>instincts</u>, which are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>causes</u> of <u>transformations</u> of <u>possibilities</u> into <u>certainties</u>, in accordance with its <u>intention</u> to <u>evolve</u> toward <u>self-perpetuity</u>. A <u>living body</u>'s genomic <u>expression</u> pattern.
- Choose To take <u>responsibility</u> for the <u>emergence</u> of a particular <u>certainty</u> from a <u>mental</u> <u>indeterminacy</u>. Decide.
- Collective unconscious The world observed by the inexistential identity that is common to all inherently conscious observers. The Jungian noumenon extended to be analogous to Kant's transcendental imagination. See Universal consciousness, Imagination.
- Compassion Any expression of empathy that embodies love.

- Complementary The <u>categorization</u> of any configuration of <u>asymmetric entities</u> whose <u>symmetry increases</u> as their <u>separation</u> decreases.
- Complete self-awareness The <u>perfect symmetry</u>, which encompasses every <u>conceivable</u>
   <u>possibility</u>, and is hidden by the self-<u>attributed uniqueness</u> of each <u>asymmetric mind</u>. Selfless
   <u>awareness</u>. See <u>Perfect symmetry</u>, <u>Real mind</u>, <u>Reality</u>.
- Conceivable Residing within the world, the inherent consciousness, or the inexistential identity of any asymmetric mind. Not necessarily existing.
- Connection The relationship between <u>entities identified</u> within the same <u>category</u> (<u>asymmetric</u>), or that <u>transcend categorization</u> (<u>symmetric</u>).
- Consciousness The <u>objectively internalized</u> and <u>subjectively embodied</u> portion of an <u>inexistential identity</u>'s <u>complement</u> that <u>distinguishes</u>, <u>categorizes</u>, <u>sequences</u>, <u>counts</u>, <u>temporalizes</u>, <u>vitalizes</u>, <u>mentalizes</u>, and <u>attributes meaning</u> to <u>beings</u> it <u>observes</u>. The basis of the <u>aspiration</u> to <u>grow</u> into the <u>real mind</u>.
- Count To identify the cardinality of the members of a given metrical category.
- Courage The capacity to resist fear and hatred.
- Creativity The capacity to increase the symmetry of knowledge, which enhances its utility.
- Curiosity The mental intention to reveal beauty by decreasing ignorance.
- Current (extrinsic) The <u>translation</u> of <u>charged matter</u> through <u>material space</u>, whose rate <u>changes subjectively express</u> inverse <u>changes</u> in its <u>objective</u> rate of <u>translation</u> through <u>time</u>.
- Current (intrinsic) The torque of the <u>rotation</u> of <u>charged matter</u> within <u>material space</u> that is the <u>subjective expression</u> of its <u>objective translation</u> along its <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and/or <u>mental</u> geodesics.

- Dark Rationalism The <a href="https://example.com/hypothetical">hypothetical</a> school of <a href="thought">thought</a>—based on the <a href="existential">existential</a> assertion that Unity underlies each combination of a <a href="conceivable">conceivable</a> being and its <a href="unique">unique</a>, perfectly <a href="complementary">complementary</a> dual—that uses <a href="reflection">reflection</a> to <a href="mailto:metaphysically</a> extend <a href="physical theories">physical</a> theories</a>, in order to generate <a href="logical conjectures explaining philosophical">logical</a> conjectures <a href="explaining philosophical">explaining philosophical</a>, <a href="scientific">scientific</a>, and <a href="mailto:spiritual">spiritual</a> mysteries concerning the fundamental nature of reality and our role in it.
- Death The cessation of a <u>body</u>'s <u>predictable</u> divergence from its <u>causal</u> path of least resistance.
- **Degrees (metrical)** The <u>metrically operation</u>al subset of a quantifiable, <u>sequential category</u> that are <u>identifiable</u> as greater than, equal to, or less than each other, based on the cardinality of <u>quanta</u> that its <u>operators express</u> as <u>separating</u> each of them from its <u>metric</u> of size.

  Numeric operands.
- **Degrees (sequential)** The members of a quantifiable, <u>sequential category</u> whose <u>identifications</u> as greater than, equal to, and less than each other, are determined by their relative position with respect to its minimum endpoint—or any maximum endpoint—based on which reside between the others and the endpoint.
- **Depression** A <u>conscious incarnation</u>'s extended <u>experience</u> of its <u>body</u>'s <u>mental inertia</u> the <u>mental expression</u> of its <u>temporal imperative</u> to pursue the path of least resistance.
- Desire Any <u>expression</u> of a <u>vital imperative</u> to <u>translate</u> toward a <u>causal body</u>, with the
   <u>intention</u> of <u>internalizing</u> its <u>usable energy</u>, for shaping <u>adaptations</u> toward <u>self-perpetuity</u>.
- **Despair** The <u>hopeless awareness</u> of the ultimate futility of <u>imperatives</u> and <u>intentions</u>. The basis of impatience. See **Equanimity**.
- Destiny Each <u>causal manifestation</u>'s <u>transcendence</u> of its <u>identifying capacities</u>,
   <u>imperatives</u>, and <u>intentions</u>. See Origin.

- Devotion A body's mental intention to sustain the object of its desire, or its aspiration to facilitate the growth of all conscious beings.
- **Displacement** A <u>unique entity</u>'s <u>expression</u> within a <u>space</u>, which <u>emerges</u> from applying its <u>operators</u> to its <u>operands</u>.
- **Distance** The <u>displacement</u> of a <u>material</u>, <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, or <u>mental space</u> through each <u>observing body</u>'s <u>expression</u> that applies local <u>operators</u> to its <u>matter</u>.
- **Distinguish** To <u>identify</u> a <u>being information</u>ally as a specific <u>manifestation</u>.
- **Domain** A collection of <u>entities</u>.
- Doubt A mental manifestation's experience of a separation between a belief and the truth.
   See Skepticism.
- Dynamics (mental) Each <u>asymmetric mind</u>'s <u>aspiration</u>al use of <u>mental energy</u> to <u>connect</u> all <u>conscious manifestation</u>s within its <u>universe</u>, and facilitate the <u>growth</u> of each of them toward <u>complete self-awareness</u>, against opposition from nonaligned <u>imperatives</u> and <u>intentions</u>.
- **Dynamics** (temporal) <u>Matter</u>'s <u>imperative</u> use of <u>temporal energy</u> to <u>connect</u> to or <u>separate</u> from <u>temporal manifestations</u> within its <u>world</u>, in its <u>translation</u> toward <u>temporal symmetry</u>, against opposition from nonaligned <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, and <u>aspirations</u>.
- **Dynamics (vital)** Each <u>lifeform</u>'s <u>intentional</u> use of <u>vital energy</u> to <u>connect</u> to or <u>separate</u> from <u>temporal</u> and <u>vital manifestations</u> within its <u>evironment</u>, in its <u>evolution</u> toward <u>self-perpetuity</u>, against opposition from nonaligned <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, and <u>aspirations</u>.
- Education Any <u>practice</u> that <u>aspires</u> to increase the <u>effectiveness</u> of a <u>mental</u> <u>manifestation</u>'s <u>intelligence</u> and <u>creativity</u>. See <u>Indoctrination</u>.

- Effect A change identified as aligned with a body's imperatives, intentions, or aspirations.
- **Elegance** The <u>utility</u> of <u>beauty</u>.
- Emergence The <u>identification</u> of an <u>entity</u> as having crossed the boundary into an
   <u>asymmetry domain</u>, from its encompassing <u>symmetry domain</u>. The hiding of a <u>symmetry</u>.

   See Transcendence.
- Emotions The expressions of a mental manifestation's intuitions, imperatives, intentions, as inertial operators that determine the shape of its local mental space. Mental mass.
- Empathy A <u>conscious observer</u>'s extension of its <u>self-awareness</u> into other <u>entities</u>.
- Energy <u>Dynamic operators</u> of a <u>causal space</u>—whose <u>observer</u> is <u>expressed</u> in their distribution within it, and <u>distance</u> from their <u>material operands</u>—that are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>translating</u> their <u>operands</u> through the <u>indeterminacies separating observer-sequenced</u>, <u>unmanifest possibilities</u>. The <u>capacity</u> to <u>traverse indeterminacies</u>.
- Energy (mental) <u>Dynamic operators</u> that are <u>expressions</u> of the <u>objective identity</u> that <u>mentally shapes a world</u>, or of its em<u>bodiment</u> therein, and are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>connecting</u> its <u>consciousness</u> to every other <u>mental operand</u> in its <u>universe</u>, with the <u>aspiration</u> of facilitating their <u>growth</u> through the <u>indeterminacies separating</u> each of them from <u>complete self-awareness</u>. A <u>mental manifestation</u>'s thoughts.
- Energy (temporal) <u>Dynamic operators</u> that are <u>expressions</u> of the <u>objective identity</u> that <u>temporally</u> shapes a <u>world</u>, or of its em<u>bodiment</u> therein, and are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>connecting</u> its <u>material manifestation</u> to other <u>temporal operands</u> <u>displacing</u> its <u>causal space</u>, under the

- <u>imperative</u> to <u>translate</u> it through the <u>indeterminacies</u> <u>separating</u> it from <u>temporal symmetry</u>. Elementary bosons.
- Energy (vital) <u>Dynamic operators</u> that are <u>expressions</u> of the <u>objective identity</u> that <u>vitally</u> shapes a <u>world</u>, or of its embodiment therein, and are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>connecting</u> its <u>living</u> <u>body</u> to other <u>vital operands</u> in its <u>environment</u>, with the <u>intention</u> of using them to <u>evolve</u> through the <u>indeterminacies separating</u> it from <u>self-perpetuity</u>. A <u>vital manifestation</u>'s heritable instincts.
- Engineering The <u>practice</u> of shaping <u>effects</u> whose transitive <u>effects</u> are <u>intended</u> to satisfy <u>imperatives</u> or fulfill <u>intentions</u>. <u>Mental expressions</u> that redirect <u>energy</u> in the service of <u>vitality</u>. See <u>Technology</u>.
- Entanglement The reciprocal <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental connections</u> that <u>emerge</u> from multiple <u>objective identities</u> <u>observing</u> interactions among their <u>subjective identities</u>, within their respective <u>worlds</u>, from which their shared <u>universe</u> retroactively <u>emerges</u>.
- Entertainment The <u>category</u> of <u>experiences</u> that are <u>intended</u> to generate <u>happiness</u> or <u>pleasure</u>.
- Entity Any conceivable possibility.
- Environment The <u>material space</u> to which a <u>manifestation</u> is <u>causally connected</u>.
- Equanimity The <u>aspirational awareness</u> of the ultimate futility of <u>imperatives</u> and intentions. The basis of patience. See **Despair**.
- Essence The <u>expression</u> of an <u>observed being</u> by its <u>observer</u>'s <u>objective identity</u>. See Appearance, Phenomenon, Truth.
- **Essential complement** The <u>domain</u> that <u>uniquely reflects</u> a given <u>essence</u>, and with which it merges to reveal reality.

- Evil Any <u>practice</u> that <u>intention</u>ally diverges from the <u>mental geodesic</u>, and therefore limits the scope of <u>justice</u>. The <u>subjective categorization</u> of any <u>being</u> that a <u>mental manifestation</u> <u>identifies</u> as <u>separating</u> it from that with which it <u>needs</u>, <u>desires</u>, or <u>aspires</u> to <u>connect</u>. See **Suffering**.
- Evolution The sharing of <u>mutations</u> within isolated populations of <u>vital incarnations</u> as <u>expressions</u> each of their <u>bodies</u>' <u>intention</u> to <u>translate</u> toward <u>self-perpetuity</u>. The <u>vital</u> analog of <u>growth</u>.
- Existence The <u>domain</u> containing everything <u>necessitated</u> by the <u>uniqueness</u> of any inexistential identity.
- Experience The <u>observation</u> of a <u>being</u> that <u>subjectively identifies</u> it as a <u>cause</u> of <u>changes</u> in a <u>manifestation</u> of the <u>observer</u>. The <u>causal</u> interpretation of <u>objective</u>, retroactive determinism.
- **Explanation** The transformation of information into objective knowledge.
- Expression [Self-] Any reflection of an [entire] entity that emerges from the operators within a space or domain that it shapes. See Information, Knowledge.
- Externalize An <u>observer</u>'s <u>identification</u> of a <u>being</u> as distinct from its <u>identity</u>. See
   Observation.
- Fact An idea that is a constituent of an epistemological framework.
- **Faith** A <u>belief</u> whose <u>justification</u> is a <u>mystery</u>.
- Fear The <u>mental imperative</u> to <u>translate</u> away from a potential source of <u>suffering</u>.
- Field (dynamic) Any <u>charge</u>'s <u>expression</u> within its local <u>space</u>, as a sub-<u>space</u> whose <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, or <u>mental energy operators</u> are <u>identifiable</u> as transitively <u>expressing effects</u>

that align any other <u>causally</u> relatable <u>charges</u> within it, with specific <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, or <u>aspirations</u> of the source <u>charge</u>. The <u>capacity</u> of a <u>material operand</u>'s <u>charge</u> to be <u>identified</u> as exerting <u>force</u> on relatably <u>charged matter</u>, which <u>translates</u> it through specific <u>indeterminacies separating observer-sequenced</u>, <u>unmanifest possibilities</u>.

- Field (inertial) Any <u>matter</u>'s <u>expression</u> within its local <u>space</u>, as a sub-<u>space</u> shaped by its <u>identity-reflecting inertial operators</u>, which are <u>identified</u> as exerting <u>force</u> on all other <u>matter</u> within it.
- Force Any use of energy by specifically charged matter, which expresses a field that is identified as a cause of particular certainties emerging from possible indeterminacies in an observer's future, in alignment with the imperatives, intentions, or aspirations of the field's source.
- Framework (epistemological) A distinct configuration of <u>facts</u> assembled in accordance with the <u>mental intention</u> to <u>identify</u> the <u>truth</u>.
- Framework (existential) A distinct configuration of wisdom assembled in accordance
  with the <u>aspiration</u> to <u>explain reality</u>.
- Free will The self-<u>identification</u> of a <u>mental manifestation</u> as having the <u>capacity</u> to <u>choose</u>—independently of the shaper of its <u>world</u>—which <u>unmanifest possibility</u> in a <u>causal</u> <u>indeterminacy</u>, <u>manifests</u> as a <u>certainty</u>.
- Friendship A mental manifestation's awareness of another's contributions to its growth.
- Frustration A mental incarnation's experience of its body's impatience with its separation from that with which it needs to connect.

- Future The temporal identification of the inherent consciousness of an objective identity, by its subjective identity, and all other mental manifestations within the world it shapes. See Past, Present.
- Genius The <u>creative intelligence</u> from which <u>wisdom emerges</u>.
- Geodesic (mental) Each <u>conscious manifestation</u>'s shortest, <u>aspiration</u>al path through the <u>indeterminacies separating</u> it from <u>complete self-awareness</u>.
- Geodesic (temporal) Each <u>causal manifestation</u>'s shortest, <u>imperative</u>-driven path through the <u>indeterminacies separating</u> it from <u>temporal symmetry</u>; any <u>predictable</u> divergence from this path of least resistance <u>identifies</u> the <u>manifestation</u> as also <u>being alive</u> or <u>conscious</u>.
- **Geodesic (vital)** Each <u>living manifestation</u>'s shortest, <u>intentional</u> path to fulfillment through the <u>indeterminacies</u> <u>separating</u> it from <u>self-perpetuity</u>.
- God The <u>identification</u> of the all-encompassing <u>real mind</u>—the <u>perfect symmetry</u> that <u>transcends existence</u>, <u>uniqueness</u>, and <u>consciousness</u>—which encompasses the <u>identification</u> of the <u>unique universal consciousness</u> residing with each <u>world</u>-shaping, <u>inherently conscious objective identity</u>, whose <u>self-expression</u> is the interiority of a distinct <u>subjective identity</u> that <u>manifests</u> as a <u>sequence of conscious bodies</u>, summarizing its <u>memories</u> of the <u>world</u> it shapes. The most <u>persistent</u> of <u>conscious spirits</u> whose <u>objective conceivability</u> or <u>subjective embodiments</u> are the <u>justification</u> of the <u>beliefs</u> that <u>identify</u> their followers.
- Gratitude A <u>conscious observer</u>'s <u>expression</u> of an <u>observed manifestation</u>'s <u>beauty</u>.
   Prayer or worship.
- Growth The <u>transformation</u> of <u>consciousness</u> into greater <u>self-awareness</u>, which is <u>subjectively experienced</u> as the increasing <u>empathy</u> that reveals the path to <u>bliss</u>.

- Guilt The negative <u>effects</u> of a <u>mental manifestation</u>'s self-<u>identification</u> as a <u>cause</u> of a <u>body</u>'s <u>separation</u> from that with which it <u>needs</u>, <u>desires</u>, or <u>aspires</u> to <u>connect</u>. See <u>Responsibility</u>.
- Habit Any <u>practice</u> that is an <u>expression</u> of a recurring <u>imperative</u>. See <u>Meditation</u>,
   Ritual.

- **Harmony** <u>Symmetric</u> alignment.
- **Hatred** A <u>mental body</u>'s <u>expression</u> of its impatience with any <u>being</u> that it <u>identifies</u> as <u>persistently separating</u> it from that with which it <u>needs</u> or <u>desires</u> to <u>connect</u>.
- History The <u>causal</u> portion of the <u>world expressed</u> by an <u>objective identity</u> that any of its <u>incarnations experience</u>d. See Future, Past, Present.
- **Hope** A mental manifestation's awareness of its destiny to transcend its causal origin.
- Human condition (the) The growth of hominids—a distinct category of mental
   manifestations—through their body's conflicting intuitions, imperatives, intentions, and ideas
   that will end with their transcendence of their causal origins.
- **Hypothesis** A <u>justifiable opinion</u>.
- Idea A mental manifestation's expression of an intuition.
- **Idealism** The school of <u>philosophical</u> <u>thought</u> based on the premise that the <u>logical</u> consistency of <u>reality</u> has a <u>mental</u> foundation.
- **Identify** To attribute an identity to an entity.
- **Identity** The name that identifies an entity.

- **Ignorance** The <u>separation</u> between a <u>mental manifestation</u> and <u>objective knowledge</u>, where its <u>doubts</u> about the <u>truth</u> of its <u>beliefs</u> and <u>opinions</u> reside.
- Imagination The <u>self-expression</u> of an <u>inherently conscious objective identity</u> within its <u>subjective identity</u>'s <u>sequence</u> of <u>bodies</u> as their interiority, which embodies their <u>mentality</u>.
- Imperative A <u>need</u> of a <u>material body</u>, with which it is <u>identifiable</u> as using the <u>energy</u> of its environment to align effects.
- Impossible The <u>categorization</u> of <u>entities</u> that can never <u>manifest</u> in the <u>world</u> of a given <u>objective observer</u>, which collectively em<u>body</u> its <u>inexistential identity</u>.
- Incarnation The retroactive <u>self-expression</u> of a predecessor <u>objective identity</u>. The <u>causal</u> <u>self-expression</u> of an <u>inertial body</u> as a <u>dynamically charged manifestation</u> that <u>emerged</u> from it <u>experiencing</u> the <u>expressions</u> of certain relatably <u>charged bodies</u> within its <u>environment</u>.
- Incarnation (mental) An <u>inertial body</u>'s <u>memories</u> of itself that extend from the <u>causal</u> <u>emergence</u> of its <u>consciousness</u> to its previous <u>thought</u>.
- Incarnation (temporal) An <u>inertial body</u>'s <u>material history</u> that extends from its <u>causal</u> <u>origin</u> to its prior <u>temporal</u> interaction.
- Incarnation (vital) An <u>inertial body</u>'s <u>adaptation history</u> that extends from its first self-sustaining divergence from the <u>causal</u> path of least resistance to its most recent <u>vital</u> experience.
- Indeterminacy A <u>material possibility</u> from which multiple, <u>observer-distinguish</u>able <u>certainties</u> can <u>emerge</u>.
- Indoctrination Any <u>practice</u> that limits a <u>mental manifestation</u>'s <u>intelligence</u> and <u>creativity</u> to a specific <u>epistemological framework</u>. See Education.

- Inertia A <u>material body</u>'s <u>capacity</u> to resist <u>change</u>.
- Inexistence The <u>categorizing asymmetry</u> of every <u>entity</u> residing beyond <u>existence</u>.
- Inexistential identity The portion of an <u>unmanifest observer</u> that em<u>bodies</u> every <u>entity</u> that can never <u>manifest</u> within its <u>world</u>. Any <u>entity</u> whose <u>uniqueness necessitates</u> the existence of all other entities.
- Infection The divergence of any of its guests' <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u> or <u>aspirations</u> from a host's <u>identifying causal geodesic</u>.
- Information The <u>observer-reflecting separations</u> that fundamentally <u>distinguish</u> the manifestation of an observed being. The categorization of knowledge. See **Knowledge**.
- Inherent consciousness The possibilities within the objective identity of an asymmetric mind—the portion of its inexistential identity's complement that it internalized—residing beyond the manifest world it shapes through essential reflection. A noumenon that is analogous to Husserl's pure consciousness.
- **Instincts** Vital intentions.
- Instincts (mutated) The <u>expressions</u> of a <u>vital manifestation</u>'s <u>imperatives</u> and <u>intentions</u> as <u>inertial operators</u> that are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>mutations</u> that determine the shape of its local <u>vital space</u>. <u>Vital mass</u>.
- Instincts (evolved) The expressions of a vital manifestation's imperatives and intentions as
   dynamic operators that are identifiable as having translated it through specific
   indeterminacies that separated its unmanifest, vital possibilities within its objective identity.
   Vital energy.
- **Intelligence** The <u>capacity</u> to <u>transform</u> <u>information</u> into <u>knowledge</u>.

- Intention A body's desire whose work is based on predictable divergences from the causal path of least resistance, and so is identifiable as decreasing the vital and mental energies available for use in the pursuit of it.
- Internalize An observer extending its identity to encompass an observed entity.
- Intuition A mental manifestation's use of its imagination to contextualize the original—though conceivably irrational—insights that constitute its objective identity's self-expression within it.
- Joy A conscious observer's experience of an observed manifestation's beauty.
- Justice Willful effects aligned with decreases in every conscious body's separation from
  that with which they each aspire to connect. Each conscious being's expression of its
  intrinsic purpose. See Vengeance.
- **Justification** The alignment of an <u>idea</u> with a specific <u>epistemological</u> or <u>existential</u> <u>framework</u>.
- **Knowledge** The <u>observer-reflecting connections</u> by which <u>observed beings</u> are <u>mentally</u> <u>internalized</u>. The <u>categorization</u> of <u>information</u>. See **Information**.
- Law of science A theory that codifies the <u>predictability</u> of the <u>effects</u> that can be <u>experienced</u> by the successors to the <u>observer</u> of a recurring <u>causal indeterminacy</u>. The <u>rational identification</u> of a <u>spirit</u>. See **Spirit**.
- Life The <u>predictable</u> divergence of an <u>inertial body</u> from its <u>causal</u> path of least resistance, using <u>energy</u> that it extracts from its <u>environment</u> to <u>evolve</u> toward <u>self-perpetuity</u>. The <u>meaning</u>less interplay of <u>need</u> and <u>desire</u>.

- Logic A rational epistemological framework that aligns ideas with facts, and premises with conclusions.
- Logical Enlightenment The <u>wisdom aspired</u> to by any <u>framework</u> in the <u>Dark Rationalism</u>
   School of <u>existential thought</u>.
- Love The <u>empathic experience</u> of increasing proximity to <u>completeness</u>, shared by <u>complementary conscious beings</u> as their <u>separation</u> decreases. The <u>identifier</u> of the <u>aspiration</u>al path of all <u>asymmetric minds</u>.
- Lust A body's vital intention to obligate the object of its desire to its evolution toward selfperpetuity. The vital analog of devotion.
- Manifestation The <u>categorizing asymmetry</u> of any <u>entity</u> that <u>exists</u> within the <u>world</u> of its observer.
- Mass The <u>observed</u> result of any <u>tangible space</u>'s <u>inertial operators</u> that <u>materially</u>
   <u>distinguish</u> their <u>operands</u> by <u>expressing</u> the kinematic size and shape of the <u>distance</u>
   <u>separating</u> them. A <u>causal manifestation</u>'s <u>experience</u> of a <u>body</u>'s <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, or <u>mental</u>
   <u>inertia</u>.
- Material space The <u>domain</u> bounded by the <u>material membranes</u> of <u>observer-sequenced</u>, <u>metrical spaces</u>, through which <u>matter</u> is <u>subjectively identified</u> as having <u>translated</u>, and in which the torque of each elementary <u>particle</u>'s intrinsic <u>rotation expresses</u> its <u>objective</u> <u>capacity</u> to <u>translate</u> along its <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental geodesics</u>. A <u>universe</u>'s <u>appearance</u> <u>domain</u> that represents the <u>transformation</u>al record of all of its <u>measurable changes</u>.
- Mathematics The <u>practice</u> of <u>identifying quantifying categories</u>, <u>sequences</u>, <u>operators</u>, and <u>operands</u>.

- Matter Any metrical operands of a universe's inertial or dynamic operators—the spatial distributions of which are expressions of the space's observer—whose separations are tangible distances.
- Meaning The difference that an <u>observed</u> <u>being</u> can make in the <u>aspirations</u> of its <u>conscious</u> <u>observer</u>.
- Measurement An objective record of an experience.
- Meditation Any <u>practice</u> that is an <u>expression</u> of a <u>conscious observer</u>'s <u>aspiration</u>, which
  maximizes its equanimity by limiting its frustration, anger, and angst. See <u>Habit</u>, <u>Ritual</u>.
- **Membrane (material)** The border of a <u>world</u>'s <u>material domain</u> that separates the <u>tangible</u> from intangible, and within which all of its <u>matter manifests</u>. The boundary of a <u>universe</u>.
- Memory A conscious observer's awareness that the past exists, and contains certainties
   whose transformations from possibilities shaped its history. The experiences attributed to any
   mental incarnation of an inherently conscious objective identity.
- Mentalize To <u>identify</u> a <u>being</u> as having <u>memory</u>, which underlies its <u>body</u>'s <u>aspiration</u> to
  grow toward <u>complete self-awareness</u>.
- **Metrical** Countable.
- Miracle An effect with no identifiable, manifest cause.
- Modal Idealism A <u>Dark Rationalism framework</u> that applies modal <u>logic</u> to <u>transcendental</u> idealism to <u>explain</u> the nature of <u>reality</u>, and the structure of the <u>mind</u>, by <u>identifying</u> the <u>purpose</u> of the latter in the context of the former.
- Morality The <u>category</u> of <u>degrees</u> to which <u>practices</u> can align with the <u>aspirations</u> of all <u>mental manifestations</u>. The basis of <u>justice</u>.

- Mortality A <u>body</u>'s <u>vital expression</u> of its <u>separation</u> from <u>self-perpetuity</u>. The basis of the vital intention to evolve.
- Mutation The <u>emergence</u> of a <u>random</u> heritable <u>effect</u> in a <u>vital incarnation</u> as an <u>expression</u> of its <u>body</u>'s <u>intention</u> to <u>evolve</u> toward <u>self-perpetuity</u>.
- Mystery The <u>information</u> that <u>identifies</u> the in<u>explicable</u>.
- Mysticism The irrational belief that there are mysteries that can never be explained. The
   sanctification of existential ignorance as an argument in support of theism, which underlies
   the mental imperative to reveal the beauty of reality in order to identify our intrinsic purpose.
- Name The <u>identification</u> of the <u>domain</u> of <u>attributes</u> that fully <u>categorizes</u> an <u>entity</u>'s asymmetry.
- Necessary The <u>category</u> of <u>possibilities</u> whose <u>existence</u> em<u>bodies</u> their <u>observer</u>'s unique self-<u>identification</u> as a <u>complementary domain</u> of <u>impossibilities</u>—whose <u>inexistence</u> it also identifies as such.
- Need Any imperative to use energy to translate toward a world in temporal symmetry.
- Noumenon Any <u>unmanifest entity</u> that <u>expresses</u> itself in the <u>manifest certainties</u> of the <u>world</u> it <u>observes</u>. See Objective identity, Phenomenon, Spirit.
- **Objective** The <u>categorizing asymmetry</u> of <u>manifestations</u> with <u>world</u>wide <u>identity</u> invariance.
- Objective identity An <u>unmanifest observer</u> that <u>expresses</u> itself in every <u>manifest</u> <u>certainty</u>, by em<u>body</u>ing all of its <u>world</u>'s <u>possibilities</u> and <u>impossibilities</u>. A <u>noumenon</u> analogous to Kant's <u>transcendental</u> ego. See **Noumenon**, **Soul**.

- **Obligation** An <u>externally</u> imposed <u>imperative</u> or <u>intention</u>. The <u>work</u> of a <u>manifestation</u> that is intended to sustain that which effectively lusts for it, or to appease that which it fears.
- Observation A <u>unique entity</u>'s <u>expression</u> of a <u>being</u> as distinct from it. See Externalize.
- **Operand** A <u>manifestation</u> to which the application of an <u>operator expresses</u> its <u>observer</u> in its local <u>displacement</u> within its encompassing <u>space</u>.
- Operator An <u>essential identifier</u> of <u>translational</u> or <u>rotational displacement</u> that <u>expresses</u> its <u>observer</u> in the <u>metrical space</u> of its <u>operands</u>. An <u>inexistential entity</u>'s <u>uniqueness</u>, which embodies the axis of <u>reflection</u> that differentiates it from its perfect <u>complement</u>.
- **Opinion** The subjective expression of an idea as fact.
- **Orientation** The configuration of <u>geodesic displacements</u> from a given <u>manifestation</u> to each of the <u>beings</u> within the <u>space</u> they share.
- Origin The emergence of a causal being's identifying capacities, imperatives, intentions, and aspirations. See Destiny.
- Particle A <u>material</u> sub-<u>space</u> comprising a <u>persistent</u> combination of <u>identifying charges</u>
   that <u>manifests</u> as a single <u>body</u>.
- Past The <u>causal</u> portion of the <u>world expressed</u> by an <u>objective identity</u> that its <u>inertial</u>
   <u>body</u> is not directly <u>experiencing</u>. See Future, History, Present.
- Patience A <u>conscious body</u>'s <u>expression</u> of its <u>equanimity</u>.
- Peace A mental incarnation's experience of harmony among its body's imperatives,
   intentions, and aspirations. See Stress.

- Perfect symmetry The primal nothingness, embodied as the foundational
  indistinguishability of all conceivable possibilities, and identifiable as their transformational
  invariance. See Complete self-awareness, Real mind, Reality.
- Persistent The tendency of an <u>identifiable manifestation</u> to recur continually within a <u>sequence</u>. The <u>categorization</u> of <u>noumena</u> whose <u>expressions</u> are continually recurring effects.
- Person The constituents of an <u>inherently conscious observer</u>'s <u>subjective identity</u>, who
  have <u>capacities</u>, <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, <u>aspirations</u>, and <u>memories</u> in common. A <u>mental</u>
  manifestation that is analogous to Kant's empirical ego.
- Perspective A <u>conscious</u> <u>being</u>'s <u>knowledge</u> of its <u>world</u>.
- Phenomenon A <u>body</u>'s <u>identification</u> of an <u>essence</u> within its <u>environment</u>. See
   Appearance, Essence, Noumenon.
- Philosophy The <u>practice</u> that <u>works</u> to <u>identify truth</u>, and <u>explain reality</u>, by developing sound arguments that draw <u>logical</u> conclusions from <u>rational</u> premises, derived from <u>intuitive</u> <u>ideas</u> regarding <u>the human condition</u>. The <u>categorization</u> of the <u>wisdom</u> revealed by this <u>practice</u>.
- Physicalism The <u>hypothesis</u> that <u>reality</u> is an <u>objective</u>, <u>tangible domain</u> comprising only <u>manifest causal space</u>, <u>time</u>, <u>matter</u>, and <u>energy</u>, in which all <u>life</u>, <u>minds</u>, and the <u>effects</u> thereof <u>emerge</u>. <u>Materialism</u>.
- Pleasure An <u>incarnation</u>'s fulfilled <u>experience</u> of a lack of <u>desire</u> for <u>change</u>, which is its <u>body</u>'s <u>expression</u> of a decrease in its <u>vital stress</u>. See <u>Happiness</u>.
- **Possible** The modality of the totality of <u>reality</u>, or of any <u>conceivable</u> <u>being</u> that can manifest within an observer's world of certainties.

- **Practice** A recurring expression of will.
- **Predictability** The <u>identification</u> of the regularity of a recurring <u>sequence</u>.
- Present The <u>causal</u> portion of the <u>world expressed</u> by an <u>objective identity</u> that its <u>inertial</u>
   <u>body</u> is directly <u>experiencing</u>. See Future, Past.
- **Proof** The logical argument that justifies the identification of an idea as fact.
- Purpose Each <u>observed being</u>'s contribution to its <u>conscious observers</u>' growth toward complete self-awareness.
- Quantum The smallest operand within a given metrical space.
- Random The <u>categorization</u> of each succession of <u>manifestation</u>s that does not correspond
  to any <u>possible countable or predictable sequence</u>.
- Rational metaphysics The <u>identifying categorization</u> of any <u>philosophical framework</u>
  based on the principle that each <u>conceivable unique observer</u>, within the <u>perfect symmetry</u>,
  embodies a hidden <u>asymmetry</u> that it <u>expresses</u> in the <u>domain</u> it <u>observes</u>, through an
  <u>existential</u> or <u>essential reflection</u>. Any <u>logical synthetic reasoning that generates a priori
  existential knowledge.</u>
- Rationalism The <u>practice</u> that <u>intends</u> to <u>identify truth</u>, by <u>transforming</u> the <u>information</u> that <u>identifies</u> a <u>mystery</u> into <u>knowledge</u> that <u>explains</u> it, through an <u>analysis</u> of it in the context of an <u>epistemological framework</u>.
- Real mind The <u>original identity</u> of each <u>asymmetric mind</u> that its <u>growth</u> toward <u>complete</u>
   <u>self-awareness</u> ultimately reveals. The <u>noumenon</u> that is analogous to Hegel's Absolute
   <u>Spirit</u>. See Complete self-awareness, Perfect symmetry, Reality.

- Reality The complete unification of a conceivable essence and its essential complement,
   which reveals the perfect symmetry and transcends existence. See Complete self-awareness,
   Perfect symmetry, Real mind.
- Reflection (essential) The <u>essential uniqueness operator</u> through which an <u>objective</u> <u>identity expresses</u> its <u>phenomenal world</u>—its perfect <u>complement</u>—and whose inverse merges them to reveal <u>reality</u>. The core <u>idea</u> of <u>modal idealism</u>.
- Reflection (existential) The foundational <u>uniqueness operator</u> through which an
   <u>inexistential identity expresses</u> its <u>existential domain</u>—its perfect <u>complement</u>—and whose inverse merges them to reveal the <u>perfect symmetry</u>. The core principle of <u>Dark Rationalism</u>.
- **Religion** A system of shared beliefs and rituals that aspires to collective equanimity.
- Responsibility A mental manifestation's self-identification as the cause of the alignment of
   effects with its internally generated imperatives, intentions, and aspirations.
- Responsible agency A mental manifestation's universe-shaping capacity to choose.
- Ritual A <u>practice</u> that is an <u>expression</u> of the <u>mental intention</u> to reinforce a shared <u>belief</u> or <u>personal value</u>. See **Habit**, **Meditation**.
- Rotation An <u>operation</u> that <u>expresses</u> a uniform <u>change</u> in an <u>operand</u>'s <u>orientation</u> with respect to all other <u>beings</u> within the <u>space</u> they share. See **Translation**.
- Sadness A mental incarnation's experience of its body's sorrow.
- Sanctified Any manifestation that is identified as being in harmony with the will that shaped its world. Sacred.
- Science The <u>practice</u> that <u>works</u> to <u>identify truth</u> and <u>explain reality</u>, by applying quantitative speculation to <u>intuitive ideas</u>, to develop <u>theories</u> that map recurring

<u>indeterminacies</u> to <u>metrical sequences</u>, and empirically confirms the <u>symmetry</u> of their alignment, by using the latter to <u>predict</u> or retrodict the former. The <u>categorization</u> of the insights that <u>emerge</u> from this <u>practice</u>.

- Self-awareness A mind's self-identification whose completeness is hidden from it by its
   attribution of uniqueness to itself.
- **Self-perpetuity** The <u>environmental immortality</u> that is the ultimate <u>effect</u> of <u>life</u>'s evolutionary work to survive.
- **Separation** The relationship between the members of <u>distinguish</u>able <u>categories</u>.
- Sequence A collinear <u>domain</u> of either <u>predictably</u> or <u>randomly</u> aligned <u>manifestations</u>.
- Sin The <u>moral categorization</u> of <u>practices</u> that prioritize the pursuit of <u>needs</u> and <u>desires</u> over their <u>transcendence</u>, and therefore prolong the <u>world</u>'s <u>suffering</u>.
- **Skepticism** The awareness of the separation between a belief and the truth. See **Doubt**.
- **Sorrow** A <u>mental body</u>'s <u>expression</u> of the <u>identified persistence</u> of its <u>separation</u> from that, with which it needs, desires, or aspires to connect.
- Soul Any <u>inherently conscious objective identity</u> whose <u>self-expression</u> is the interiority of the <u>mental manifestation</u>s that constitute its <u>subjective identity</u>. Any <u>persistent spirit</u> that is also em<u>bodied</u> as a <u>manifestation</u> within the <u>world</u> it <u>observes</u>. See **Objective identity**, **Spirit**.
- Space Any manifest domain in which an asymmetry is identifiable. See Category.
- Space (causal) The configuration of <u>inertial</u> <u>distances</u>, <u>separating</u> the <u>manifestations</u> within a <u>tangible domain</u>, whose shapes <u>reflect</u> the <u>effects</u> of its <u>causal bodies</u>' <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental masses</u> on each other. The configuration of <u>dynamic</u> <u>distances</u> <u>separating</u> successive

- instances of each <u>causal body</u> within distinct <u>observer-sequence</u>d, <u>tangible domains</u>, whose shapes reflect the effects of their contents' temporal, vital and mental energies on each other.
- **Spirit** A <u>noumenal entity</u> em<u>bodied</u> as either sustained or recurring cooperation among causal manifestations.
- Spirituality Any system of <u>beliefs</u> and <u>practices</u> that <u>aspires</u> to generate <u>persistent</u> equanimity and <u>explain reality</u>, using <u>wisdom</u> derived from the <u>noumenal</u> coherence underlying sustained or recurring cooperation among <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental</u> <u>manifestations</u>. The <u>categorization</u> of the <u>wisdom</u> revealed by such a system.
- Stress A <u>manifestation</u>'s <u>imperatives</u> and <u>intention</u>s that are in opposition with each other,
   or with its aspirations. See Peace.
- **Subjective** The <u>categorizing asymmetry</u> of <u>manifestation</u>s with <u>world</u>wide <u>identity</u> variability.
- Subjective identity The <u>sequence</u> of embodiments of an <u>inherently conscious observer</u>'s self-<u>identification</u> as a <u>manifest mind</u> with a distinct <u>history</u>.
- Suffering A mental manifestation's experience of recurring negative effects of the
   persistence of its separation from that with which it needs, desires, or aspires to connect. See

   Evil.
- Symmetry domain A collection of <u>entities</u> that are in<u>distinguish</u>able with respect to the <u>attributes</u> that <u>emerge</u> in any <u>asymmetry domain</u> within it.
- Tangible The <u>categorization</u> of any <u>metrical manifestation</u>'s <u>attributes</u> that em<u>body</u> its <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, and <u>aspirations</u>, and so are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>causes</u> or <u>effects</u> within its <u>environment</u>. Any <u>space</u> containing such <u>manifestations</u>. See <u>Membrane</u>.
- Technology Effects that are expressions of engineering. See Engineering.

- **Temporal symmetry** The state <u>identifying</u> any <u>environment</u> that contains no <u>usable</u> <u>energy</u>.
- **Temporalize** To <u>identify</u> a <u>metrical manifestation</u> as residing within an <u>environment</u> where it embodies <u>imperatives</u> to <u>use energy</u> to <u>translate</u> toward a <u>world</u> in <u>temporal symmetry</u>.
- Theism The <u>belief</u> in the <u>existence</u> of <u>persistent conscious noumena</u> that <u>cause</u>d the phenomenal world; and can express themselves in effects there.
- Theology The practice that aspires to explain our existential origin, purpose, and destiny in the context of the primal noumena that facilitate all temporal, vital, and mental cooperation, based on an existential framework comprising spiritual texts and commentaries that are identified as their writers' divinely inspired insights and revelations.
- Theory A falsifiable <u>fact</u>.
- Thoughts The expressions of a mental manifestation's intuitions, imperatives, intentions, aspirations, and memories, as dynamic operators retroactively identifiable as having translated their conscious operands through particular indeterminacies that separated their unmanifest, mental possibilities within its objective identity. Mental energy.
- Time The <u>transformations</u> that traversed <u>observer-sequenced unmanifest indeterminacies</u>, which retroactively form the <u>material space</u> containing a <u>manifestation</u> to which their <u>objective observer</u> has <u>attributed</u> its <u>identity</u>. The <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental indeterminacies</u> within a given <u>objective identity</u> that <u>separate</u> the <u>predictable</u>, <u>transformational sequences</u> involving its possible <u>manifestations</u>, and therefore em<u>body</u> the <u>unmanifest possibilities</u> that are <u>identifiable</u> as <u>causally</u> shaping particular <u>manifest certainties</u>. See <u>Material space</u>.
- **Transcendence** The <u>identification</u> of an <u>entity</u> as having left a given <u>asymmetry domain</u>, for an encompassing <u>symmetry domain</u>. The revelation of a <u>symmetry</u>. See **Emergence**.

- Transformation The <u>material</u> record of any <u>operation</u> that traversed the <u>indeterminacies</u> <u>separating unmanifest possibilities</u>, by <u>translating</u> the <u>identities</u> of its <u>operands</u> through <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental space</u>.
- Translation Any <u>operation</u> that <u>expresses</u> a non-uniform, <u>change</u> in an <u>operand</u>'s <u>orientation</u> with respect to all other <u>manifestations</u> within the <u>space</u> they share. See **Rotation**.
- Translation (mental) A body's self-expression of its mental incarnation through the imperative, intentional, and aspirational stages of consciousness toward a domain of pure bliss.
- Translation (temporal) A body's expression of its temporal incarnation through the fields
  of other charged bodies, toward a world in temporal symmetry, which resides beyond all
  such fields.
- Translation (vital) A body's expression of its vital incarnation through evolving cycles of
  the stages of mortality—inception, symbiosis, individuation, maturation, reproduction,
  senescence, and expiration—toward an environment in which it resides beyond the reach of
  death.
- Truth An <u>objective identity</u>'s <u>knowledge</u> of an <u>observed essence</u> within its <u>world</u>. All objective knowledge of a world. See **Appearance**, **Essence**, **Phenomenon**.
- Understanding The process through which a <u>mental manifestation internalizes knowledge</u> of <u>beings</u>, by <u>transforming its separation</u> from them into a <u>connection</u>, with the <u>intention</u> of decreasing its <u>ignorance</u>. The <u>transformation</u> of <u>curiosity</u> about a <u>domain</u> into an <u>identification</u> of its <u>beauty</u>.

- Uniqueness An entity's axis of reflection across which it expresses its complement as the domain it observes. The necessitation of the existence of the complementary domain observed by an inexistential entity.
- Universal consciousness The <u>inexistential identity</u> that is shared by every <u>conceivable</u>
   asymmetric <u>mind</u>, and so is the source of all <u>meaning</u> in <u>reality</u>. The <u>noumenon</u> that shapes
   the <u>categories</u> of Kant's <u>transcendental imagination</u>, to form the <u>collective unconscious</u>. See
   Collective unconscious.
- Universe A <u>domain</u> of <u>worlds</u> that are <u>causally entangled</u> through the retroactive, <u>history</u>merging intersection of their <u>observers</u>' <u>objective identities</u>.
- Unmanifest The <u>categorization</u> of each <u>noumenon</u> residing beyond the <u>manifest</u> <u>world</u> it shapes through <u>essential reflection</u>.
- Usable energy The <u>capacity</u> to <u>traverse indeterminacies</u> in an <u>observer</u>'s <u>future</u>, which decreases with each <u>predictable effect</u> that its <u>causal manifestation experiences</u>, and increases with each <u>effect</u> that <u>emerges</u>, without an <u>identifiable cause</u> from the <u>observer</u>'s <u>objective identity</u>. The <u>operators</u> of the <u>material space traversed</u> by <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, and <u>aspirations</u>.
- Utility The <u>degree</u> to which a <u>manifestation</u> aligns with all of the <u>temporal</u>, <u>vital</u>, and <u>mental geodesics</u> in a <u>universe</u>.
- Value (extrinsic) A <u>conscious observer</u>'s <u>identification</u> of the <u>utility</u> of a <u>being</u>, which embodies its worth to other observers.
- Value (intrinsic) The intersection of internally generated <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, or aspirations of a mental manifestation. Mental charge.

- Velocity The <u>material expression</u> of the angle between the <u>objective</u> directions of <u>temporal</u>,
   <u>vital</u>, or <u>mental transformation</u> of an <u>observed</u> <u>manifestation</u>, and those of its <u>inertial</u>
   <u>observer</u>.
- Vengeance A mental manifestation's intention to maintain or increase another's separation from that with which it needs or desires to connect, as a consequence of the former, or its proxy, identifying the latter as having intentionally, and unjustifiably, done the same to it. See Justice.
- **Vitalize** To <u>attribute</u> to a <u>temporal body</u>, a self-sustaining <u>intention</u> to diverge <u>predictably</u> from its causal path of least resistance, in an evolutionary pursuit of self-perpetuity.
- Wave The <u>transformation</u>al probability distribution that em<u>bodies</u> a given <u>manifestation</u>'s possible material state changes, and resides within its observer's objective identity.
- Will A <u>mind</u>'s <u>choice</u>s that align <u>effects</u> with its <u>body</u>'s <u>imperative</u>s, <u>intentions</u>, or <u>aspirations</u>.
- Wisdom The <u>symmetric connections</u> that extend beyond the <u>objective knowledge</u> of a given <u>world</u>, to <u>explain reality</u>.
- Work A <u>body</u>'s reaction to <u>effects</u> as aligning with its <u>imperatives</u>, <u>intentions</u>, or aspirations.
- World The portion of the <u>complement</u> of an <u>inexistential identity</u> that its <u>objective identity</u> externalizes—and shapes to <u>reflect</u> the <u>internalized</u> portion—as the <u>observation</u>al reference frame that is its <u>subjective identity</u>'s <u>domain</u> of <u>manifest certainties</u>.

Conclusion

The primary objective of this glossary to make the theorists in each existential field, aware that

their terms of art have meanings in the other fields. It represents a potential first step—in a

unified language—toward the syncretizing of philosophy, science, theism, and spirituality. The

predictable lack of agreement on these definitions may at first seem to imply that this is a step

backward. However, if this disagreement produces work toward a consensus on the meaning of

these terms, that will be a step in the right direction.

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
