This research looks at Ernest Hemingway's A Farewell to Arms and The Sun Also Rises in order to explore the specific characteristics found in Hemingway's code hero as these heroes share certain attitudes and characteristics found in all Hemingway's novels. This project wants to illustrate the Phillip Young's concept of code hero in Hemingway's selected novels as he is the first scholar who has created characteristics Hemingway's code hero for the first time. He has named these heroes "code hero" due to certain characteristics such as sense of nothingness, grace under pressure, courage and dignity that recur through all these code heroes. By introducing this type of hero, Hemingway has added a new branch to the theory of heroism. By using heroism theory this project wants to illustrate the fundamental similarities and differences of this new type of hero with other definitions in heroism theory. This research will next examine the complexities and integrities found in Hemingway's code hero. Due to direct relationship between Hemingway's background and his code heroes, this thesis also discusses how Hemingway tries to foreshadow his own life and moralities in his



code heroes and will relate the creation of this certain hero to the characteristics of Hemingway's spiritual life. This research also examines how Hemingway throughout depiction of his code hero and especially with the description of nada conception highlights the pessimistic view of the code hero and shows the position of early modern man in civilized society.

Kajian ini menyelidiki novel Ernest Hemingway: A Farewell to Arms dan The Sun Also Rises, untuk mengenal pasti ciri khusus hero Hemingway. Projek ini berharap dapat menjelaskan konsep kod hero Phillip Young dalam novel pilihan Hemingway. Young telah menamakan hero Hemingway berdasarkan beberapa karekteristik, seperti konsepsi nada, kelembutan ketika tekanan, keberanian dan digniti yang sering wujud pada zaman Perang Dunia Pertama. Dengan memperkenalkan jenis hero sebegini Hemingway telah menambah satu lagi cabang baharu dalam teori heroisme. Oleh itu, projek ini berharap dapat menjelaskan karekteristik asas kod hero Hemingway berdasarkan konsep Phillip Young dan kajian ini juga bertujuan untuk memperkembang dan memperluas konsep ini dan menambah bahawa karektor wanita dan karektor sampingan juga mempunyai kesamaan dengan kod hero dalam novel Hemingway. Projek ini juga mengkaji kepelbagaian dan keutuhan kod hero Hemingway. Berdasarkan hubungan yang langsung antara latar belakang Hemingway dan kod hero, kajian juga membincangkan cara Hemingway membayangkan kehidupannya sendiri dan aspek moral pada kod heronya dan kecenderungan untuk mengaitkan maklumat



yang telah disebut terdahulu terhadap karekteristik kehidupan dan cara hidup Hemingway. Kajian ini juga mengkaji bagaimana Hemingway, melalui gambaran hero dan heroin beserta ciri khusus, terutama deskripsi konsepsi nada, menonjolkan kekaburan dan kepesimistikan nada kehidupan dan perkara ini memperlihatkan keadaan manusia awal moden dalam masyarakat yang bertamadun.
