Maizulina was diagnosed with leukemia last month after completing her Master's degree in Communication.

"We noticed that she had started losing her hair and looked pale. We found out about her illness in September and she started going for treatment. She seemed energetic. Even during Hari Raya, she ate normally and spent time with her siblings as usual.

"But, on Oct 18, at 1.25am, she left us. I was holding her in my arms when she died," said Zulkeply at Universiti Putra Malaysia's (UPM) 40th convocation.

The convocation was presided over by Sultan of Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, who met Maizulina's parents after the ceremony.
