PRANICA RECEIVES BUSINESS AWARDS

CHARLESTON -- Eve Pranica, daughter of Alan and Valerie Pranica of Bourbonnais, is the recipient of five awards from Eastern Illinois University's Lumpkin College of Business and Applied Sciences.

They are the Dean's Award, the Management and Marketing Departmental Award, the St. Louis

Chapter of the American Marketing Association Outstanding Student Award, the Phi Gamma Nu Scholarship

Key and the Delta Sigma Pi Scholarship Key.

The Dean's Award, established by the first dean of the School of Business -- James Giffin -- and his wife, June, is awarded to a senior nominated by a faculty member and chosen by the department chairpersons and dean. Delta Sigma Pi keys are presented annually to the student(s) with the overall highest grade point average. Eastern's chapter of Delta Sigma Pi, an international business fraternity, recognizes outstanding graduating business students with scholarship keys.

Phi Gamma Nu keys are awarded to the senior student(s) with the highest scholastic averages.

Pranica received a perfect 4.0 grade point average.

Pranica, a Spring 1997 EIU graduate, is a 1993 graduate of Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School in Bradley.
