

REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (April 13-14)

MEN'S TRACK: The Panthers won their only dual meet of the season defeating Indiana State, 84-74, behind the outstanding performance of CLAUDE MAGEE (see below).

CLAUDE MAGEE (Clermont, FL), senior sprinter, accounted for 18 of EIU's 84 points as he won three individual events and ran legs on two winning relays . . . he won the long jump in 24-1, the 100 meters in 10.4, the 200 in 21.6 (into the wind) and anchored the 400 relay which tied a school record in 40.7 . . . EIU was ahead by five points entering the last event when it won the 1600 relay in 3:22.3 with Magee running the third leg.

JIM LAIL (Dolton-Thornridge), junior weightman, was EIU's No. 2 scorer with 13 team points as he won the shot put in 57-1 and the discus in 167-1 . . . his shot put distance was just one inch shy of his school record 57-2 which he set earlier this spring . . . he also was second in the hammer Saturday with a 152-4 distance.

LARRY THOENNISSSEN (Morton), junior weightman, won the hammer in 165-5, took second in the shot put at 53-8 and was third in the discus in 160-5 . . . his nine team points ranked him third on the team.

JIM MATON (Shelbyville), freshman middle distance runner, was the team's fourth highest scorer with 7½ points . . . he won the 800 in 1:55.7, finished third in the 1500 in 3:59.7 and ran a 49.0 split on the winning 1600 relay which was clocked in 3:22.3.

DALE RIGHTER (Mattoon), freshman distance runner, won the 3000 steeplechase in 9:37.1 . . . he has already cut 20 seconds off his time in that event this spring.

LARRY PRIEBE (Palos Hills-Stagg), junior weightman, won the javelin with a distance of 199-7.

BASEBALL: The Panthers split with Southern Illinois-Edwardsville on Saturday . . . EIU won 9-2 but then lost 2-0 . . . Eastern was rained out of a doubleheader with St. Louis University on Sunday . . . the Panthers now have an 18-9-1 record.

MONTY ALDRICH (Louisville-Olney CC), senior centerfielder, led the offensive attack in Saturday's first game by getting three hits including a two run triple . . . he continues to lead the team with a .410 batting average . . . he also leads the Panthers in hits (34), walks (29) and runs scored (27), and is fielding .980 with just one error out of 49 chances in centerfield.

TIM PARKER (Charleston-Lake Land CC), senior leftfielder, is the No. 2 hitter with a .381 average . . . he leads the team with six homers, has 20 RBIs and is fielding 1.000.

TIM TORRICELLI (Springfield), junior third baseman, has a .341 batting average, third best on the team, and is tied for the team lead with six homers . . . he has 21 RBIs, and is tied for most runs scored with 27 . . . he's also fielding .932.

BERNIE HOLLAND (Olympia Fields-Thornwood), sophomore designated hitter, has a .329 average with 24 hits in 73 at-bats, five homers and 23 RBIs.

KENDALL SNYDER (Raymond-Lincolnwood/Lincoln Land CC), junior first baseman, is hitting .321 with 27 hits in 84 at-bats . . . he has three homers and a team high 24 RBIs . . . he's also fielding .990 with just two errors in 189 chances.

RICK STERIOTI (Joliet-Catholic), sophomore second baseman, is batting .311 with 23 hits in 74 at-bats . . . he has only struck out four times, fewest of any of the regulars, and is fielding .920 with just two errors out of 137 chances . . . he's knocked in 10 runs.

MICK FREED (Lexington), senior righthanded pitcher, allowed just six hits in the 9-2 win over SIU-E although two of those were back-to-back homers . . . he now leads the team with a 4-1 record but has a 6.23 ERA with 24 earned runs in 34 2/3 innings . . . he has struck out 19 while walking 15.

DAVE GOODHUE (Armstrong), sophomore righthanded pitcher, was Saturday's tough luck pitcher as he allowed just five hits and two unearned runs in the 2-0 loss to SIU-E . . . he now is 1-1 with a team best 1.97 ERA . . . he has allowed just seven earned runs in 32 innings, struck out 30 and walked just nine.

BRIAN CORN (Elgin), freshman righthander, is 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA . . . he has struck out 31 in 28 1/3 innings to lead the club in that department but also has walked 20 batters to lead in that category . . . he did not pitch over the weekend.

MIKE STEINKAMP (Lincoln), junior righthanded pitcher, has a 3-2 record with 5.06 ERA . . . he did not pitch during the weekend . . . he has allowed nine earned runs in 26 2/3 innings with seven strikeouts and seven walks.

BILL JOSE (Salem-Mineral Area CC), junior righthanded pitcher, improved his record to 2-1 after defeating the University of Illinois last week, 8-2 . . . Jose now has a 3.68 ERA allowing just nine earned runs in 22 innings . . . he has 17 strikeouts and five walks.

WOMEN'S SOFTBALL: The Lady Panthers dropped three of four conference games last week to run their record to 13-9 overall and 2-9 in the Gateway Conference. EIU lost 3-2 and 2-0 to Southwest Missouri and split with Wichita State (1-0 and 2-1). Senior pitcher/designated hitter Shelly Eddington (Brighton/Southwestern) collected five hits over the weekend.

SHELLY EDDINGTON (Brighton/Southwestern), senior pitcher/designated hitter, is among the league-leaders in hits with 21. She owns a 6-6 mark on the mound with an ERA right around 1.00.

ANGEL LENDVAY (Mundelein), freshman outfielder, leads the team with 27 hits and 11 RBI. Among the league's leaders in hitting all season, Lendvay drove in the winning run in the Lady Panthers' come-from-behind 2-1 win over Wichita State.

TANGI WALDROP (Robinson), senior catcher, had a pair of two-hit games last weekend against Wichita State and Southwest Missouri. She has 15 hits and leads the club in sacrifices with five.

ZAM MOGILL (Streator), freshman pitcher, ran her record to 7-3 while splitting a pair of league games. She got the victory in EIU's 2-1 win over Wichita State and suffered a disappointing 2-0 loss to Southwest Missouri. Mogill retired 14 of the last 15 SMS batters she faced. The pressure-packed performer leads the club in strikeouts with 53.

WOMEN'S TRACK: The EIU women's track squad dropped an 80-55 decision to Indiana State at Terre Haute, Ind. The Lady Panthers captured four firsts in three individual events and one relay.

JANINE JARRIS (St. Charles), sophomore middle-distance performer, placed first in the 1,500 meter run with a time of 4:46.6. She also placed third in the 800 meter run with a clocking of 2:25.

LAUREN LYNCH (Elmhurst/York), freshman middle-distance runner, won the 800 meter run with a 2:19.3 performance. She also was a member of the first-place 1,600 meter relay team.

VALETA STRICKLAND (Chicago/South Shore), sophomore thrower, won the shot put with a toss of 44-1. She also placed third in the discus.

WOMEN'S TENNIS: The EIU women's tennis squad was nipped by Western Illinois 5-4 in a match at Weller Courts. The Lady Panthers sport a 3-8 mark while trying to snap a six-match losing streak. Eastern winners against WIU include: No. 5 singles LORI ZUPANCI (Edwardsville), No. 6 singles (GINA ANDRES (Mascoutah), No. 2 doubles SALLY STOUT (Peoria/Richwoods) and Andres, and No. 3 doubles PATTI KEARNS (Palatine/Fremd) and Zupanci.
