CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University will offer 23 graduate and undergraduate courses and workshops this spring semester at Chanute Air Force Base. Seven graduate courses in educational administration, counselling, and technology are included in the course offerings.

A graduate course in curriculum development, a graduate course in philosophy of education, a course in statistics in education and psychology, undergraduate courses such as Understanding Art, Principles of Career Development, Small Group Communication, Plants And Civilization, The United States, Caribbean, And Central America, Manufacturing Management, and The Structure of English are examples of some of the courses that EIU will bring to the Rantoul area.
