MINUTES

The minutes of February 22, 2002, were approved as published and without objection.

CORRESPONDENCE

Executive Action memos regarding the following were shared with the committee:

1. INT 3353 – add INT 1363 as a prerequisite, effective Spring 2002 (approved – CAA minutes 4/11/02)
2. EIU 4160 – add “business majors and students who have earned credit in BUS 3710 or FIN 2710 are excluded”, effective Spring 2003 (approved – CAA minutes 4/18/02)

NEW BUSINESS

Dr. Sam Guccione from INT presented proposals for two new course courses, INT 2523 (Routing and Switching Fundamentals), and INT 3153 (Advanced Routing and Switching). These courses are needed to update skills needed for INT/TED graduates and will become effective with the 2003-2004 catalog. T. Waskom (Dilworth) moved to accept INT 2523 with minor revisions and R. Pace (Waskom) moved to accept INT 3153 with minor revisions. Motion carried. Voting will take place at the next meeting in early fall.
