#### Glass Bead Making (ages 15 & over)

This intensive weekend workshop will teach beginners all they need to know to create glass beads using Mapp gas and a "hothead" torch. For those with some experience, different techniques will be explored. Topics to be covered include glass physics, the history and types of glass, proper handling and use of equipment, surface decoration, shaping the glass, and making a bead within a bead.

## Burnishing Techniques with Colored Pencils (ages 15 & over)
