Exploring Media in Drawing

Mondays and Wednesdays, 6:30-8:30pm, August 4-13

Fee: 50.00 for members, 60.00 for non-members

This course will explore a variety of both contemporary and traditional drawing techniques. For each session, participants will use a different media to create a unique drawing. Media such as inks, sepia and sanguine chalk, pastels, charcoal, carbon and graphite will be used. Subject matter will include the figure, portraits and still life.

Opaque Painting: Techniques in Oil

Tuesdays and Thursdays, 6:30-8:30pm, August 5-14 Fee: 75.00 for members, 90.00 for non-members

Working from a still life, participants will create two paintings using oil paint. A variety of techniques will be explored as well as painting on a stretched canvas and a wood panel. Topics include color mixing and relationships, glazing, opacity and transparency of paint. The workshop fee includes a set of paints for each student.

Advanced Techniques in Glass Bead Making

Instructor: Dave Hunter

Friday, August 8, 6-9pm; Saturday, August 9, 9am-4pm

Fee: 70.00 for members, 84.00 for non-members

This intensive weekend workshop will introduce a variety of advanced techniques in glass bead making using a "hot head" torch. The workshop will cover heart-shaped beads, hollow beads, including the bead-within-a-bead, using enameling powders, and creating complex stringers for use in cased floral and landscape beads.

Registration deadline: August 1

Cancellation Policy: The Tarble Arts Center has the option of canceling a class or workshop if there are fewer than the minimum number of students required.

Refund Policy: If the Tarble Arts Center cancels a class due to insufficient enrollment, the class fee will be refunded. A student withdrawing from a class after enrolling must notify the Tarble Arts Center on or before the registration deadline to receive a full class refund. Because classes are funded on a break-even basis, no refunds will be made for withdrawals after the registration deadline.
