Shrub Swamp Community in the floodplain north of the Mackinaw River. Local dominants were *Populus deltoides* (shrub) and *Salix interior* (shrub). Additional associates include: *Salix nigra* (shrub), *Alisma subcordatum*, *A. triviale*, *Persicaria pensylvanica*, *Leucospora multifida*, *Eleocharis ovata*, *Cyperus strigosus*, and *Lycopus americanus*.
