(13.55 kilometer) of town of St. Anne, Leesville 7.5 minute quadrangle. Elevation
about 670 feet.
Growing in old field, cultural community. Growing with *Solidago canadensis*, *Agrostis*
gigantea, *Poa pratensis*, *Potentilla simplex*, *Prunella vulgaris*, *Hypericum majus*,
Viola primulifolia, *Oxalis dilenii*, *Rhynchospora capitellata*, etc.
