Black oak sand savanna within swale, moist area with no trees and a few shrubs
Cephalanthus, Cornus, Rhamnus, Salix, Onoclea sensibilis, Thelypteris palustris, Acalypha rhomboidea, Agrimonia parviflora, Carex stricta, Eupatorium perfoliatum, Hypericum spp., Lycopus virginicus, Solidago gigantea, Spartina pectinata, etc. Blue flowered perennial herb.
