80°22.5-22.9' Barely S of the Indian River County line, ca
0.4-0.7 mile W of U.S. 1; along series of dirt roads;
mostly wet flatwoods with scattered marshes and wet
prairies. Associates: *Polygala rugelii*, *P. setacea*, *P.*
nana, *Rhynchospora* spp., *Scleria* spp., *Ludwigia* spp.,
Eleocharis spp., *Panicum* spp., *Serenoa*, *Pinus*, *Ilex* spp.,
Lyonia spp., *Smilax* spp., *Quercus* spp. Vine over other
shrubs; leaves silvery white below; fruits reddish.
