40.65651° Latitude -89.12595° Longitude 682 Ft. Elevation

Quadrangle: Secor Mackinaw River Watershed

ParkLands Foundation's Chinquapin Bluffs Preserve; located approximately 5 miles north of Carlock, Illinois. Map Datum: WGS84/NAD83.

Dry-mesic Upland Forest Community, growing near the edge of the woods; degraded (grazed) in the past. Associated species include: *Quercus velutina*, *Q. imbricaria*, *Maclura pomifera*, *Prunus serotina*, *Cornus racemosa*, *Rubus occidentalis*, *Elaeagnus umbellata*, *Lonicera maackii*, *Toxicodendron radicans*, *Monarda fistulosa*, *Muhlenbergia* sp., *Bromus inermis*, and *Solidago canadensis*. In fruit. Seeds more rounded than *V. vulpina* (see PBM #5754).
