Illinois: Macoupin County
39.21254° North Latitude, -089.988° West Longitude ± 20 feet (WGS84/NAD83)
Beaver Dam State Park. About 6.5 mile southwest of Carlinville and on the north side of Macoupin Creek. Polk Township. Plainview Quadrangle. Elevation about 600 feet. Growing in dry upland forest with *Carya ovata*, *Celtis occidentalis*, *Quercus alba*, *Quercus velutina*, *Ulmus rubra*, *Circaea*, *Eupatorium rugosum*, *Geum canadense*, *Phryma leptostachya*, *Sanicula odorata*. Found in dead *Morus* sp. Grape fruits at this time were green and had a bloom on the fruit.
