about 680 feet.
Growing in heavily disturbed dry sand savanna along old dirt road to old home site,
cultural community. Growing with Pinus strobus, Sassafras albidum, Pinus resinosa,
Quercus velutina, Prunus serotina, Quercus alba, Poa pratensis (abundant), etc.
