Associated species include: *Ulmus rubra*, *Gleditsia triacanthos*, *Platanus occidentalis*, *Cercis canadensis*, *Zanthoxylum americanum*, *Toxicodendron radicans*, *Laportea canadensis*, *Solidago gigantea*, *Campanulastrum americanum*, *Cuscuta gronovii*, *Sicyos angulatus*, and *Cryptotaenia canadensis*.
