Hooper Branch Savanna Nature Preserve, UTM 16, 453013mE, 453914mN, Leesville
7.5 minute quadrangle. 2 mile south and 9 mile east of St. Anne.
Growing in open black oak dominated sand savanna, Kankakee Sand Area of the Grand
Prairie Natural Division. Elevation about 675 to 680 feet. Growing with *Quercus*
velutina, *Corylus americana*, *Ceanothus americanus*, *Carex pensylvanica*,
Sisyrinchium albidum, *Lithospermum carolinense*, *Phlox bifida*, *Smilacina stellata*,
Carex muhlenbergii, etc. Blue flowered perennial herb.
