*Viola sagittata* Aiton

Illinois: Iroquois County  
41° 00' 14" North Latitude; 087° 33' 31" West Longitude  
Hooper Branch Savanna Nature Preserve. UTM 16, 453013mE, 453914mN. Leesville  
7.5 minute quadrangle. 2 mile south and 9 mile east of St. Anne.  
Growing in open black oak dominated sand savanna, Kankakee Sand Area of the Grand  
Prairie Natural Division, Elevation about 675 to 680 feet. Growing with *Quercus*  
*velutina*, *Corylus americana*, *Ceanothus americanus*, *Carex pensylvanica*,  
*Sisyrinchium albidum*, *Lithospermum carolinense*, *Phlox bifida*, *Smilacina stellata*,  
*Linaria canadensis*, etc. Perennial herb with blue flowers.
