

Donovan 7.5 minute quadrangle. 2 mile south and 7 to 10 mile east of St. Anne.
Growing in sedge meadow. Kankakee Sand Area of the Grand Prairie Natural Division.
Growing with Quercus palustris, Platanthera flava var. herbiola. Veronica scutellata,
Nyssa sylvatica, Carex suberecta. Thelypteris palustris, Lycopus americanus,
Sisyrinchium atlanticum, Agrimonia parviflora, Glyceria striata, Eleocharis wolfii,
Eleocharis sp., etc. Blue flowered perennial herb, lateral and lower petals all bearded.
