Kankakee Sands Area Section of the Grand Prairie Natural Division of Illinois,
Bentley/Crawford-Jordan Site. About 3.75 mile north (6 kilometer) and 9.4 mile east
(13.55 kilometer) of town of St. Anne. Leesville 7.5 minute quadrangle. Elevation
about 685 feet.

Growing in dry sand savanna. Growing with *Quercus velutina*, *Sassafras*
albidum (seedlings and saplings), *Prunus serotina* (seedlings), *Rubus*, *Antennaria*
plantaginifolia, *Poa pratensis*, *Phlox bifida*, *Rosa carolina*, *Carex pensylvanica*,
Arabis lyrata, *Lithospermum*, etc. Perennial herb, flowers dark purple.
