Growing in an open sandy area along a ditch. Associates include: *Rubus setosus*, *Prunus serotina*, *Sassafras albidum*, *Salix humilis*, *Populus alba*, *P. tremuloides*, *Carex umbellata*, *C. emmonsii*, and *C. pellita*.
