Dry-mesic to Mesic Upland Forest Community dominated by *Quercus muhlenbergii*; growing on a very steep southeast-facing slope. Additional associates include: *Q. alba*, *Q. velutina*, *Fraxinus americana*, *Carya tomentosa*, *Aesculus glabra*, *Cercis canadensis*, *Viburnum prunifolium*, *Zanthoxylum americanum*, *Prunus virginiana*, *Lonicera reticulata*, *Parthenocissus quinquefolia*, *Celastris scandens*, *Aquilegia canadensis*, *Carex blanda*, *Sanicula odorata*, *Phlox divaricata*, *Trillium recurvatum*, *Arisaema triphyllum*, *Podophyllum peltatum*, *Triosteum perfoliatum*, and *Polygonatum commutatum*.
