Illinois: Iroquois County

Growing in wet prairie. Kankakee Sand Area of the Grand Prairie Natural Division.
Growing with scattered *Quercus prinus*, *Sorghastrum nutans*, *Potentilla simplex*, *Viola sagittata*, *Achillea millefolium*, *Claytonia virginiana*, *Poa pratensis*, *Spiraea*, etc. Was growing beneath a *Prunus serotina*. 100+ plants here. Perennial herb.
